O God, who in the abasement of your Son have raised up a fallen world, fill your faithful with holy joy, for on those you have rescued from slavery to sin you bestow eternal gladness. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

OUR PRIORITY THIS YEAR

During the week of June 21, the priests of the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis gathered with Archbishop Hebda and Bishop Cozzens for the biennial Presbyteral Assembly. This year’s assembly focused on unity, fraternity, and health within the presbyterate. We attended conferences on the four levels of happiness, broke into small groups for discussion, and reviewed the results of a survey measuring various aspects of priestly life. I remain hopeful that what we covered will prove fruitful in my own priesthood, and I ask your prayers that I remain faithful to the resolutions I made during the week.

On Wednesday evening, Archbishop Hebda addressed his priests and shared his vision for the archdiocese. That vision, at least for the next year, can be summed up in one word: Synod. The Archdiocesan Synod is the priority of the archbishop, and thus for the archdiocese, the parishes in the archdiocese, and the people of the archdiocese. And so it is that the priority for Good Shepherd during this next year will be the Synod.

What does that mean for us? It means that as we return again to a regular rhythm of life in the parish — a rhythm of prayer, Mass, and the sacraments — all of our additional gatherings, events, and programs will work to boost Good Shepherd’s participation in the synod process. When we pray on First Fridays, we’ll pray for our participation in the synod. When we gather for donuts or picnics or beer, we’ll encourage each other to participate in the synod. And so on.

So what is a synod again? The aim of the Archdiocesan Synod is to help the archbishop discern and establish clear pastoral priorities for the local church in a way that will both promote greater unity and lead us to a more vigorous proclamation of the good news of Jesus Christ. When Archbishop Hebda called for the synod, he expressed his desire for the archdiocese to be a “listening Church” — to hear and respond to the needs of the faithful — and the responsibility of the faithful to share their needs with their bishops. Part of this already happened. During the Prayer and Listening Sessions back in 2019, more than 8,000 faithful provided more than 35,000 comments on both what is working well in the

archdiocese and where we face challenges moving forward together. Based on this feedback, Archbishop Hebda determined the three focus areas that will shape the rest of the synod. This is where we are now, and how we are being called to participate. Our participation in the synod process will take place by way of the Synod Small Groups. The archbishop is calling on all of us to participate in small group sessions that will address the three focus areas:

- 1) Forming parishes that are in the service of evangelization
- 2) Forming missionary disciples who know Jesus’s love and respond to his call
- 3) Forming youth and young adults in and for a Church that is always young

How will we do that? At Good Shepherd, we will have a couple of ways for you to participate in a Synod Small Group.

- The primary way to participate is to sign up to be in a committed small group. In the coming weeks, we will provide a way for you to do that. You will be able to sign up as an individual seeking a small group, as a few folks looking to be placed in a small group together, or as a complete small group of six to eight people. Here, we encourage you to lean into some affinity groups that already exist, such as fraternal groups from Exodus 90, book clubs and bible studies, fourth grade moms, Knights of Columbus, the Respect Life Committee, and friend circles.
- The other way is to participate in our open sessions. These will be for people who are unable to commit to a steady small group throughout the process. Good Shepherd will host these open sessions.

What should I be doing now? For now, we encourage you to set aside some time in the fall and to start thinking about the small group that you will pull together. You can also start looking for six two-hour blocks between September 19 and November 14 when you and your group can complete the sessions. We recognize that this is a sacrifice — be we are confident it is a sacrifice that will be good for the Local Church, for Good Shepherd, and for you.
