**A NOTE ON TRADITIONIS CUSTODES
POPE FRANCIS AND THE EXTRAORDINARY FORM**

You may have heard about the recent *motu proprio* from Pope Francis, titled *Traditionis custodes* (Guardians of the tradition). With this document, our Holy Father redefined the use of the Extraordinary Form Mass, granting the decision to allow its use to the local bishops. Subsequently, Archbishop Hebda sent the clergy of the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis a letter providing some short-term direction. He wrote: "I will need some time to study the new norms, examine our local situation and seek counsel. With that in mind, I am happy to grant the necessary faculties so that those priests who are already celebrating the rites of the Extraordinary Form may continue to do so. I similarly direct that the Mass in the Extraordinary Form continue in those locations where it is currently being offered in the Archdiocese. No new public liturgical celebration of the Extraordinary Form, however, should be introduced anywhere in the Archdiocese at this time without my written permission."

What does this mean for Good Shepherd? For the time being, it means that we will continue with our celebration of the Extraordinary Form Mass on First Saturdays and a few other times throughout the year. Please pray for our Holy Father, our Archbishop, and for the faithful around the world — that we will enjoy unity in the Body of Christ, not allowing different liturgical expressions and preferences to become sources of division.

**FROM FATHER MARQUARD:
MONEY, MONEY, MONEY**

Last Sunday after Masses and donuts, I made my way home to the rectory at Our Lady of Grace, where I live with four other priests. Soon after entering onto Highway 100 heading south, I was flanked by some impressive vehicles. An Audi all the way to the left, a Tesla in the center lane, a BMW in front of me, and a Porsche in the exit lane to my right. I was deliberating which of them I would like in a straight-up trade for my Volkswagen, when something better appeared in my rearview mirror. A Ferrari Portofino. "Man," I thought. "There is a lot of money out there. And so many ways to spend it."

I don't know if any of you have \$215,000 to drop on an Italian convertible like the one I saw last Sunday, but I do know you have many choices for how and where to spend your money. And I know that this has been a year of great uncertainty. For these reasons and more, I am incredibly grateful at your continued generosity. Our collections for the fiscal year came in \$56,000 ahead of budget and \$41,000 better than last year. You are awesome.

Thank you for your support of this place. Thank you for trusting our leadership with your donations. Thank you for making it possible for us to continue with our efforts to make Jesus known, loved, and served.

Later this fall, you will receive an annual report with further details about the financial health of Good Shepherd. Please know that our principal, our trustees, our finance council, our school advisory board, our buildings committee, and I are doing our best to be prudent with your contributions and our care for the temporal goods of our parish and school.
