**SYNOD SMALL GROUP
SIGNUPS ARE COMING**

On several occasions throughout the last year, Archbishop Hebda has shared his desire for all members of the faithful in the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis to participate in the Archdiocesan Synod. He is calling on all parishes and parishioners to engage in the Synod Small Group Process, which will facilitate discussion on the future of the local church. In addition to the small groups people form and host in their homes, parishes will hold open sessions. We are hopeful that you will participate. Ideally, this will be through your forming of small groups of 6-10 people with members of the parish with whom you already have a relationship. This could be existing small groups, a group of your friends, members of organizations such as the Knights of Columbus, other parents from the school, and the like. Short of having your own groups, you can join the open sessions at Good Shepherd. These will take place on the following dates:

**FIRST FRIDAY NIGHT OF PRAYER
FRIDAY, AUGUST 4, AT 7:00 PM**

Please join us in the church this Friday, August 4, for our First Friday Night of Prayer. This is a time of Eucharistic Adoration, common prayer and praise, and the opportunity for the Sacrament of Confession. During this time, we present our hearts and lives to our Eucharistic Lord and call upon his Most Sacred Heart for mercy and blessings. The hour of prayer generally includes times of silence, songs of praise and worship, litanies or chaplets, and Benediction. Come for some or all of the hour.

**FROM FATHER MARQUARD:
ADORING THE LORD — A CALL FOR YOUR TIME**

I have been heartened in recent months by the number of people who stay after daily Masses to adore the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. This is a testimony of the love our people have for our Eucharistic Lord. Having adoration throughout the week is a true gift — especially when adoration accompanies the Sacrament of Confession. This allows people to spend time with the Lord preparing to receive his mercy and time to spend in thanksgiving for mercy received.

During the past several months, our confessional has found a temporary home in the front of the church — a home prompted by pandemic directives and precautions. This placement has worked, though it is not ideal. Given what we know now about the behavior of the virus, and at the request of several penitents at Good Shepherd, I would like to return to the confessional in the back of the church. At the same time, I would like to continue our practice of Eucharistic Adoration during confessions. Given that I will soon be behind a closed door without view of the Blessed Sacrament, this move will require some committed adorers. And so, I am asking for a few of you today.

Before we can return to the confessional, I will need to have at least two adorers committed to the following times:

- Mondays: 8 to 9 a.m.
- Tuesdays: 8 to 9 a.m.
- Wednesdays: 8 to 9 a.m.
- Fridays: 8 to 9 a.m.
- Saturdays: 8 to 9 a.m. and 9 to 10 a.m.
