

"Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful!"

~ Ancient Prayer ~

Have you ever thought about how rain falls from the sky to water the earth? How the same simple H2O brings life to every living thing — to plants, to insects, to animals, to us, to everything? The fact is, without water nothing lives.

Yet all livings things are different. Trees are tall and woody producing fruit, nuts, or seeds while fragrant flowers fit in your hand looking pretty. Rabbits hop, eagles soar, snakes slither, gophers dig, horses gallop, fish swim, and monkeys swing. You get the idea. The life produced in each living thing is unique while the thing that gives life is utterly simple and the same — water.

The Holy Spirit is likened to water that falls from heaven. When our hearts are open, the Spirit of God's love permeates our souls to give us spiritual life. When our hearts are like stone, we are spiritually dead.

Though we receive the Holy Spirit at Baptism, how often do we open the spigot to let our souls be watered? Unless we pray with our hearts, unless we turn on the spiritual spigot, the Fountain of Life, the Holy Spirit, does not give us spiritual life.

That we may grow in our spiritual lives, let us pray. Let us pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon ourselves and upon the people of St. Donatus, St. Alexius, St. Francis de Sales, Sts. Peter & Paul, Our Lady of the Angels, St. Paul's, Holy Family School, and the Centre for Christ.

On another note, I want to thank all the people who envisioned, donated, and worked on the Rosary Garden located between the Centre for Christ and St. Paul's. It is a beautiful place to make a small pilgrimage. It was blessed on the Feast of the Visitation of Mary, May 31, along with an inaugural recitation of the rosary. 


