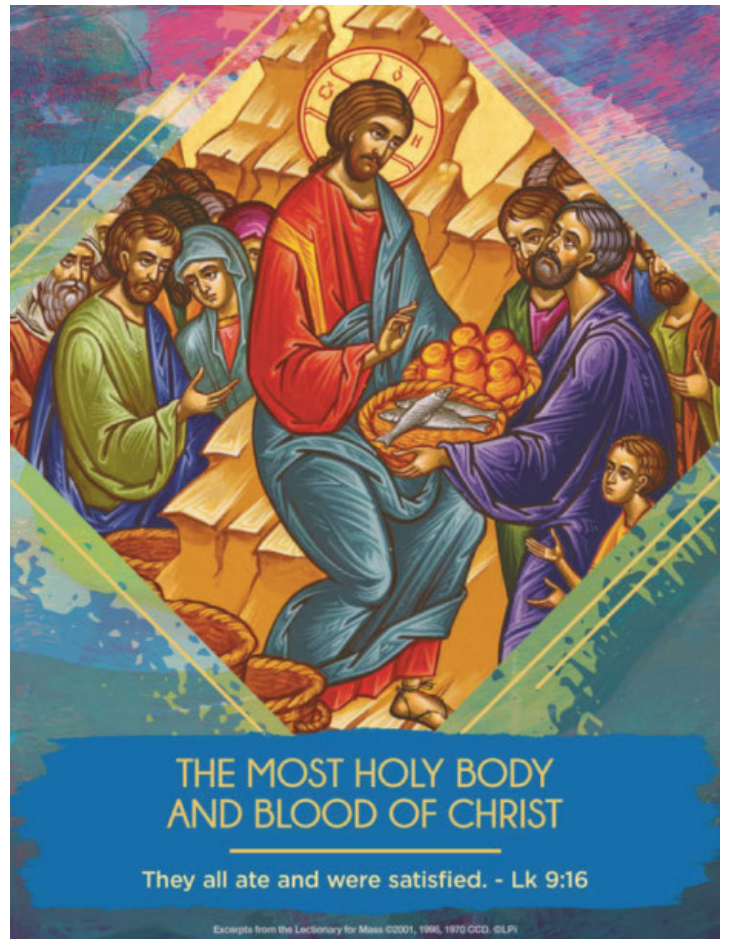

“They all ate and were satisfied!”

~ Luke 9:17 ~

Today kicks off a three year National Eucharistic Revival. It is an initiative of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). It begins on this great Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

Did you know only about one third of professed Catholics believe in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist? Sadly, many have drifted from this central truth of our Catholic Faith. We need to pray for them, teach those who will listen, and welcome them to receive Jesus in the Eucharist with faith.

Jesus says, “I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world” (John 6:51). Jesus is the Bread of Life; that means the Sacred Host we receive in Holy Communion is JESUS; It is His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains, “The Eucharist is ‘the source and summit of the Christian life’” (1324). Everything we believe flows from Jesus in the Eucharist. And worship of Jesus in the Eucharist is the highest form of worship possible on this side of heaven.

That is why as Catholics we celebrate Mass every weekend as a community of believers. It is why a priest makes great effort to celebrate the Eucharist every day inviting others to join him at daily Mass in various places.

To worship the Eucharist is to worship the person of Jesus Christ. And whenever we worship Jesus, we are worshipping God the Father and the Holy Spirit. This truth is expressed in the doxology of Mass when the priest says or sings, “Through him, and with him, and in him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, for ever and ever. Amen!” (Roman Missal).

Many parishes celebrate today’s Feast with an outdoor procession of the Blessed Sacrament. It is a public profession of our faith in Jesus’ Real Presence in the Eucharist. Our Lady of the Angels and St. Paul’s have shared this custom for years making pilgrimage by literally following Jesus. You are welcome to join the Eucharistic Procession beginning at OLA at 11:30am this Sunday.
