

#### Message from Fr. Rick



Almost 3 years. It's hard to believe that it's come to the end so soon! I will deeply miss you. These years have been wonderful and I will always hold them as a precious treasure. In particular, I'm grateful that I in fact got to have a whole extra year with you than usual, probably in part due to covid disruption, but blessings in often come in disguise.

Many people have asked me if I'm excited, which is a good question. My answer may seem to be anticlimactic: in some ways yes, in some ways no. I know there will be good things there and that I will miss a lot here, as well as challenges to take up there and to leave behind here since there are always pros and cons to everything. But I am excited in an ultimate sense, because this is God's will, and there is nothing more exciting.

Our readings this weekend are filled with scenes of passing on the mantle, inheritance, freedom to serve, mission, and calling to mission. Thus we learn in the scriptures and see in the lives of the saints that wherever God calls us to be, and whatever He calls us to do, there is where we find happiness. Could Jesus have avoided Jerusalem and the Cross? Why would he? That's precisely why he came, he is not surprised by it. So we should not be surprised or balk at where God calls us in our mission. Remember, celibacy and its detachment reminds us that here is not our home, heaven is, while at the same time, marriage and family give us an image to begin imagining in earthly terms what heaven is like perfectly.

So please, continue praying for me, all priests, and each other, so that together, as the one, Body of Christ, we may pilgrimage to and can at last arrive at our heavenly destination and always be together, forever, through Him, with Him, and in Him.

#### ST. THOMAS MORE



"I am the King's good servant, but God's first." So said St. Thomas More, whose feast we celebrate on June 22nd. St. Thomas More was once Sir Thomas More, a lawyer and statesman in the court of King Henry VIII. When the king wished to dissolve his marriage to Catherine of Aragon -- who was infertile -- the pope held up the validity of the marriage. Desperate to generate an heir, King Henry declared himself the head of the Church of England and granted him-

self an annulment. Most leaders signed the "Oath of Supremacy," declaring the King's power over the English Church. Thomas More, then the Lord Chancellor, refused to sign. He was sentenced to death. St. Thomas More reminds us of our call to integrity and to the defense of truth in the public square. Thomas More is the patron saint of lawyers, politicians, and civil servants.


