



## A NEW CREATION

*“So whoever is in Christ is a new creation: the old things have passed away; behold, new things have come. All of this is from God.”  
~ 2 Corinthians 5:17-18 ~*

People are often relabeled when they accomplish something or change major behavior. For instance, when a law student passes the Bar Exam, he or she is called a lawyer. Someone who gives up eating meat is called a vegetarian.

When someone becomes a Christian, it is not a personal accomplishment or just a change of behavior. It is what God does which motivates a change of lifestyle. To be Christian is more than just treating people nicer or going to church. Those are external expressions of something good that has happened in us. To be a Christian is more than just doing what Jesus Christ does; it is that “Christ lives in me” (Galatians 2:20).

There are some who have a conversion to Christ like St Paul — through some big spiritual experience or “aha moment.” More people have a series of smaller ongoing conversions like St. Peter. Either way, it is God who changes our lives when we cooperate with Him.

Notice, to become a Disciple of Christ is more than just a fix. Those who hit rock bottom are often more open to God transforming their lives than those who think they just need “a little fix.” Jesus doesn’t want to just fix us; He wants us to be "new creations!"

In other words, Catholicism can’t be an add-on to our busy lives. It must be central to who we are — how we live and breathe depends on Jesus Christ living inside of us. You are a new creation in Christ, let the old things of your life pass away and embrace the new things God has in store for you.






