MADE WITH PURPOSE

"For I know well the plan I have in mind for you . . . plans for your welfare and not for woe, so as to give you a future full of hope." ~ Jeremiah 29:11 ~

Have you ever been tempted to think God did not have your best intentions in mind? Don't be afraid to get serious with God. He says, "I have come that you may have life, and have it more abundantly." (John 10:10) We were made to do God's will — to know Him, to love Him, and to




