

THE PROBLEM OF SIN



"No trial has come to you but what is human. God is faithful and will not let you be tried beyond your strength; but with trial he will also provide a way out, so that you may be able to bear it." ~ 1 Corinthians 10:13 ~

There are two prevailing attitudes about sin in our culture. One, sin doesn't exist. It sounds something like this, "For me there is no moral evil, just bad choices or mistakes." Accepting the truth about sin is often deflected with thoughts like, "I'm only human" or "I didn't know better." Nonetheless, sin is real.

Two, sin is fun. Getting drunk with friends, talking poorly about others, shopping excessively, being sexually promiscuous, etc. are often glorified in today's culture. Advertisers even mock the idea of sin with sayings like, "Have some, it is sinfully delicious." But sin is just a poor temporary fix that leaves us worse off than we were before. It is not fun for long.

So what is sin? The Catechism of the Catholic Church states, sin is "an offense to God as well as a fault against reason, truth, and right conscience." Think about it. Does our world want us to live by reason, in the truth, and by right conscience?

The world doesn't want to talk about sin; it wants to talk about how we "feel". And when feelings lead the way, we are in for catastrophe. When facts lead the way, feelings will eventually follow.

St. John Paul II said, "Sin constitutes man's misery." In other words, when we believe the empty promises of temptation — like a fish following a lure full of hooks — we are caught and feel worse than if we'd followed our conscience.

Sure, sin makes God upset with us. But it also goes against the way we were made to live. Said positively, God loves us so much He does not want us to be separated from Him by sin!
