

SEEK HIM: LENT 2022



On any given day I may receive a phone call, an email, or a drop-in visitor who is seeking something. Sometimes a person comes knowing what they are seeking – to join or return to the church, to understand something about the church, or someone to talk to about the struggles of life. Sometimes I have people come to me not knowing exactly what they are seeking but they have a

great desire to find it. I believe that most people who enter my office are ultimately seeking Jesus – to know him, to love him, and to follow him – but aren't able to put it into words, or even fully understand what that means, yet. We are often like blind Bartimaeus (Mark 10:46-52), the lame man lying next to the pool (John 5:2-9), or even the rich young man (Mark 10:17-22) – we think we know what we seek, to see, to be carried, to be saved, but if we dig deeper we find that it is not only the human action we seek, but it is also the loving glance and spiritual touch of Jesus.

This weekend at the 10:30 Mass we will have the Rite of Sending for our two catechumens, **Tyler** and **Jade**. After many months of preparation, these two individuals, with their family, sponsors, and RCIA team, are being "sent" to the Rite of Election on Sunday afternoon with Bishop Joensen. At this celebration the Bishop welcomes Tyler and Jade into their final preparations to be fully initiated (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist) into the life of the Catholic Church. Both of them have been on a long journey of seeking and will soon join us fully at the Eucharistic table. Keep them in prayer this Lenten season as they spend time in deeper prayer and reflection.



san cathedral during a Liturgy of the Word and not a Mass. After the homily, the catechumens are presented to the bishop. As their names are called, the catechumens may stand in their place or move into the sanctuary near the bishop so the assembly can see them. Once they are called, the bishop questions the godparents and the assembly to ensure the catechumens' readiness to be admitted to the sacraments of initiation. Then the bishop invites the catechumens to inscribe their name in the Book of the Elect. After everyone has signed the book, the bishop declares the catechumens to be members of the elect who will celebrate initiation at the next Easter Vigil. The liturgy continues with intercessions for the elect, a special prayer over them, and a dismissal.

1st Sunday in Lent

Dt 26:4-10 | Rom 10:8-13 | Lk 4:1-13

GROW: AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

If you are anything like me, you may still be deciding what to give up or do for Lent even though we're already five days in. I know ... "Stop procrastinating!" Today's readings can help us enter more deeply into this season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. They are a reminder that Lent isn't primarily about us, as if it were a self-improvement project, but about taking the opportunity to go deeper into our relationship with God. Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are ways of reducing distractions in our life and focusing on God's mercy, his sacrifice for us, and his generosity and love. I am one who likes to control things and make plans, so the readings challenge me to look beyond myself, beginning with prayer, and ask the Lord to help me grow in faith. Paul writes, "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." Jesus exemplifies this dependence on God, allowing himself to be led to the desert by the Spirit. Each time the devil tempts him, he responds and in turn shows us how to respond: by turning to God and God's words, the source of our strength. As we choose how to observe the next 35 days, we are reminded to ask God to help us find those things that help draw us closer to him.

GO: EVANGELIZE | PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

What comes to mind when you picture a desert? I imagine sand, heat, thirst. It's more challenging to examine the landscape of my personal desert - barren places of prayer or too much focus on the details of everyday life. Lent, however, presents a rich opportunity to pause and reprioritize our lives based on Jesus' words in today's Gospel: "You shall worship the Lord, your God, and him alone shall you serve." Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving can help us do that, reminding us of our dependence on God and helping us shift our focus from ourselves to God and others. How we observe and experience Lent will differ for each of us. Whatever our personal desert looks like, we can rest assured that God will help us find our way back to him.

ACCOMPANIENT: Find an accountability partner for Lent who can help you stay the course these next 40 days. Perhaps you can pray together each day, or simply send

a text sharing how God is working in and through you in this penitential season.
