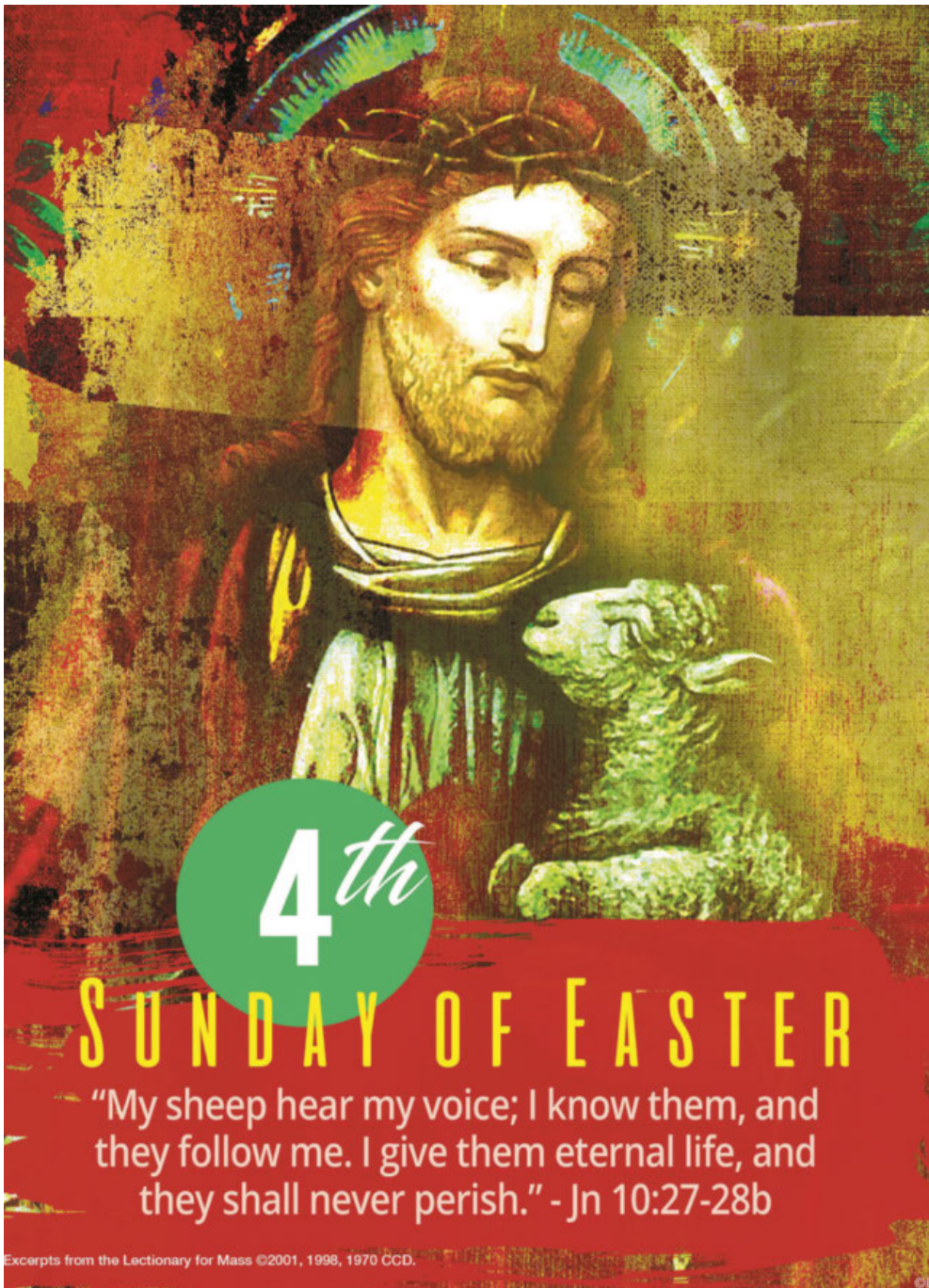

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER DAVE

ST BRIDGET LAUNCHES A NEW ENDEAVOR

OK, it's not like we are trying to compete with Harmony in the Park or anything. But we are presenting our own little music program this summer. We are calling it St. Bridget's Summer Concert Series.

Perhaps you have seen the flyers in the Narthex. The Concert Series will consist of four one hour concerts of four different styles of music. There will be no admission charge, but we will gladly accept any free will offerings. We are able to offer this series because of the generosity of the estate of Hank and Rita Peloquin. Hank and Rita were specifically supportive of the music program at St. Bridget's. In fact, Rita was a member of the choir. After they passed away the family made a donation to the parish that allowed us to purchase a larger and higher quality grand piano which we continue to enjoy today. Since there was money left over from that purchase, Tim, our Music Director, proposed that we use the remainder of the funds to offer a small series of free concerts and they agreed.

The first in the series will be Thursday May 19th at 7:00 pm. It will be an organ concert by Mr. Bill Chouinard who grew up at St. Bridget's and now serves as Organist and Music Coordinator at St. Andrew's Lutheran Church in Mahtomedi. Bill tells me that St. Andrews has the largest pipe organ in the Twin Cities.

Ever since we purchased our Rodger's electronic organ, I had dreamed about having a concert to demonstrate to the parish the capabilities of this amazing instrument.

However, with no career organist in the parish, that dream has thus far gone unfulfilled. When Tim told me that Bill was to be our first concert, I asked him to choose music for this concert that can demonstrate the variety of sounds and instruments that our organ

can produce, from soft and gentle flutes and strings, to bold and brassy horns and bass. Bill said that he'd be happy to do so and chose music that is fun to listen to. He will also do some commentary as he goes along. Bill is widely known as a professional organist in the Twin Cities area and beyond. In my brief encounter with him he is extremely knowledgeable and also very engaging.

The second offering in our concert series will be on Thursday June 23, also at 7pm. It will be an Evening of Jazz with the CC Septet. Come to relax and soak in the mellow sounds of live jazz to help you to take a respite from the occasionally frantic pace of summertime activities.

The third concert on Thursday evening August 4th at 7:00pm takes us into an experience of the Gospel Music genre and immerses us in some of the classic songs which represent a perhaps more spirited approach than the typical Catholic fare. How blessed we are to have such a variety of ways to praise God!

We conclude the series with a final concert on Thursday September 22nd at 7:00pm with a combination of Music and Comedy provided by 3 local talents including our own Tim Lackas, Mike Hubbard who has led us in music at more than a few Saturday night Masses, and the wit and talent of Karl Kornowski. It should truly be a fun and entertaining evening.

I hope that you will join us for these four evenings of enjoyment. All are welcome to attend, invite your friends and spread the word throughout the Lakes Area as well. See you on the 19th.

It's that time of year when our Confirmation candidates are preparing for the next step, and Sacrament, in their faith walk, and I don't believe the importance of this Sacrament can be over-emphasized. Let's just go with a quick synopsis as to why and what that entails. When we are Baptized, we are given new life. At Holy Eucharist, our life is nourished, and at Reconciliation, life is restored when it is broken, and then at Confirmation, that life is strengthened by the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Because we never out grow a deeper knowledge and appreciation of our faith, Confirmation signals a continuation of that growth.

Not only does the Sacrament of Confirmation help us remain faithful to our baptismal commitment to be a witness of Christ and to serve others, but the gifts of the Holy Spirit, wisdom, understanding, knowledge, counsel, fortitude, piety, and fear of the Lord, make it possible to fulfill our baptismal calling.

Now, I did not tell you anything most of you didn't already know. Every year Theresa asks for prayer partners for our Confirmands. What this means is she gives us the name of one or more Confirmation candidates that we will pray for throughout the year, encouraging them to grow stronger in the Spirit and their faith. Then, near Confirmation, she has us write them a letter, again, offering encouragement and sustenance.

Because this is my column, I would like to offer up the letter that I wrote to my Confirmand this year.

"Dear Peter Blair Denis Bernard Noone (not their real name), It has been a pleasure praying for you these past months. This next step in your faith walk is obviously extremely important. But please remember, that is just what it is, one more step on a path that is narrow, rocky, slippery, and strewn with a multitude of distractions. Please try to remember, the thought process, in order of importance in what God asks of us.

1. GOD

2. Others

3. Me

Keep God first in your heart and mind and numbers 2 and 3 will just fall into place. I know, so much easier said than done, right? It is not easy, and it does take a tremendous amount of work, but anything worth having is certainly worth working for, and I can't think of anything worth working for more, or more worthwhile, than an eternity with God.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

Reluctant Sheep

Sheep get an awfully bad rap, linguistically. Some are quick to label people as “sheep” if we think they haven’t sufficiently questioned authority or if they’re too willing to go along with someone else’s plan. We say someone has “the wool over their eyes” if they aren’t willing to see what we think is very obvious. “A wolf in sheep’s clothing” is what we call someone looking to take advantage of those too gullible to identify a real threat. Taking all this into account and considering how often we are referred to as sheep in Scripture, you’ve really got to wonder if God trying to tell us something about ourselves.

If you look at the phraseology associated with sheep, it’s no wonder that nobody *wants* to be one. Sheep are innocent. Sheep can’t protect themselves. They’re vulnerable and easily misled.

We want to see ourselves as the opposite of all that. We like to think we’re shrewd, with plenty of common sense. We want to believe that we don’t have to rely on anybody for anything. We would sooner identify with the wolf than with the sheep — at least the wolf can take care of himself. We do this because we often resist the need to rest in the greatness of God. Like a child walking to school alone for the first time (forgetting his mom is following watchfully in the car), we want to think we can handle it all by ourselves.

The truth is that God *is* trying to tell us something by comparing us to sheep: *You don’t have to do this on your own.* Every time I look at an obstacle and think that there is no way around it, I am forgetting that I have a shepherd who knows the location of the gate.
