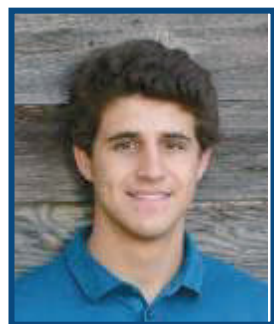
**Catherine (Cat) Williams**

**"Peace is a precious gift, which must be promoted and protected...Never has the use of violence brought peace in its wake. War begets war, violence begets violence." (Pope Francis)**

**"My heart is broken today. We're a small community and we're going to need your prayers to get through this." (Mr. Hal Harrell, Superintendent of the Uvalde School District)**

**This was a quote I heard over and over on that dreadful day of the Uvalde school shooting. It has implanted itself in my memory. As the days go by I want to remember that the greatest gift we can give this aching community may be the gift of PRAYER.**

**As I watched President Biden and First Lady Jill's visit to Uvalde, Texas, I was moved by their attendance at Mass on Sunday. I was also moved by a most beautiful reverent act performed by First Lady Jill Biden as she visited each of the crosses and pictures of the children and teachers who were killed. She reverently touched each picture in a sign of acknowledgement of this gift of human life. I found it to be a beautiful act of prayer. It stirred in me the Holy Spirit's desire that we must do everything in our power to honor life in children, teenagers, and the vulnerable in our midst. We pray that we may hold kindness in our hearts toward all people and treat them with dignity and respect.**

**We pray that we might refuse to bully anyone and replace such action and attitude with gentle love toward one another.**

**We pray for the vulnerable children in our midst that we might protect them by being adult examples of people of trust and love for one another.**

**We pray that we may refuse to use language that puts people down and causes disrespect and dishonor.**

**We pray for the courage to put an end to gun violence no matter how challenging the task.**

**We pray that we might follow Jesus, our non-violent leader.**

**We pray for the families and the school family of the people of Uvalde, Texas that Your peace and healing might reign.**



**May the Word of the Lord be on my mind, be on my lips, and be in my heart. This is a great place to start, because it brings us so close to Jesus, and, because this is where we left off. We are about to hear the Gospel of the Lord. After the Gospel, we say "praise to you Lord Jesus Christ," because God has just spoken to us. This is so important because the priest will now bow down and kiss the words of the Gospel on the page, asking that the words of the Gospel wash away our sin.**

After the Gospel comes the homily, where the priest busts open the word of God. He breaks down the readings and the Gospel into applications that people such as myself can relate to. You might say he amplifies the Word of God and how, when carried out, it has the ability for us to transform our own lives.

And now for the Creed. Please Stand. Hold on to that active posture. This summary statement of our Christian faith has been honed for hundreds of years, but professed for thousands. This faith, that we profess on the Lord's Day, has been, and still is, suffered and died for all over the world.

Next comes the Prayers of the Faithful. During this decisive moment, we stand and pray together as the Lord's faithful. They usually begin with a prayer for our Church, and progressively get closer to home. While our responses to these prayers are repetitious, we must remember that we are talking to and petitioning our God, and we should respond with a laurel and very hardy, **"Lord hear our prayer."**

Now we sit down for the Offertory. This is **not** an intermission, and please put that bulletin down. We are about to give our gifts and show our support for the mission of the church. Along with our monetary gift, we can place our other gifts and needs on the altar, as well. While the priest is lifting up the gifts to God, we also, as Catholic Christians, and anointed as Kingdom Priests, are also invited to participate in the sacrifice on the altar. The question is, just what will we place on the altar? Are there people in our lives that need to be prayed for, or is there someone in our lives that we have run out of ways to help? Place them on the altar. Are we, ourselves, in a place of joy, for all the gifts God has given us? Put them on the altar. Are there people that we love that God has placed in our lives? You know where they go. That's right, put them on the altar. Again, this is no time to relax, but a time for great intentional action, the action of offering our needs, our sorrows, our thanks, and our joys to God.

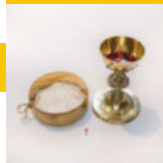
