

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER DAVE

MEMORY LANE - 5 YEARS AGO - JULY 2017

This summer marks 5 five years since St. Bridget's massive outdoor repair projects. There were essentially 3 projects happening simultaneously 1) the chimney/belltower, 2) the waterproofing, and 3) the parking lot. If you were present, do you remember the upheaval this caused all summer?

#1-CHIMNEY/BELLTOWER TUCKPOINTING REPAIR



(See picture above) First the old brick had to be removed. It literally broke and fell off as soon as they begin chipping away.



Next the new matching color brick was installed and the top chimney cap repaired. The bell was later removed, refurbished and re-installed.

#2-WATERPROOFIING



Blue liquid below the orange line shows blue dyed water leaking under church block wall where it meets the concrete foundation. Leaking was serious.



Below ground perimeter walls of church got new waterproofing (black substance), new blue pipe system to collect roof water from downspouts, and underneath the blue pipes is new drain tile system.

#3-PARKING LOT



Early stages of underground pipe drainage system showing concrete catch basins, blue connecting pipes, rock fill and chimney work in background. Giant underground pipe system was installed beneath the parking lot to collect all rainwater from entire parking lot surface and roof runoff and hold it for slow release to meet then current MnDOT standards. Replaced 1200 dump trucks of "bad dirt" under parking lot with "good dirt".
