

Message from the Pastor

125 Years of St. Joseph's Church

The special "Year of St. Joseph" concluded on Dec. 8, 2021. Pope Francis explains that this special year was "to increase our love for this great saint, to encourage us to implore his intercession and to imitate his virtues and his zeal,"

Beginning December 8, 2020 we devoted an entire year to not only honor St. Joseph but to also increase our devotion to him. There is no greater model than St. Joseph from whom we can learn how to be faithful to God, how to seek His will and to quietly accept it In our everyday life.

Although recently we have been emphasizing the 150th Anniversary of Immaculate Conception parish, we have to mark down another anniversary, that is the 125th Anniversary of St. Joseph's Church in Beroun. Sunday, March 20, 2022, a day after the feast day of St. Joseph, we will give thanks to God for our ancestors who built our beautiful church in Beroun, and passed on to our times the faith and devotion to the Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Closer to the celebration, there will be more details about this feast day and the anniversary of St. Joseph's Church, but I think it is appropriate to mention it now, particularly during Advent, while we prepare ourselves for Christmas and, like St. Joseph, quietly following the Star of Bethlehem.

As our ancestors chose St. Joseph to be the patron Saint of our parish community, our guardian and protector, so we call him today to protect us and help us to pass our faith unstained to generations to come.

Let us continue to pray for each other this Advent season so we can soon joyfully celebrate the Nativity of our Lord in Bethlehem's manger.
