


The Conversion of St. Paul

There are just three saints who have two feast days celebrated each year. One is St. Joseph - March 19 is the traditional feast day of St. Joseph, Husband of Mary, and May 1, the feast of St. Joseph the Worker. Another one is St. John the Baptist – June 24 we celebrate his Nativity, and August 29 his martyrdom, sometimes known as the Beheading of St. John the Baptist.

The third one is St. Paul. Well, kind of. "Kind of" because one of his feast days, June 29, is shared with another great apostle, St. Peter.

Tuesday, January 25 is the feast day of the Conversion of St. Paul. Originally known as Saul - a Roman citizen and a Pharisee, who persecuted Christians, including the first martyr, St. Stephen. It was on his way to Damascus, where he planned to arrest Christians, when "a light from the sky suddenly flashed around him. He fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?"" (Acts 9:4). What happened after, most of us know the story – he became an unstoppable force for the kingdom of God. known as an Apostle of the Nations. Thirteen of his letters are in the New Testament, often read during the Mass. Paul was eventually arrested in Rome and was then beheaded in the year 67 AD.

On one of our stained glass windows he is portrayed with St. Peter. Paul is the one shown here with the sword.



Although the feast of the Conversion of St. Paul has been a part of the Church calendar for more than 1500 years, it seems that it often goes by without notice.

Spiritually, Paul journeyed from a strong hatred of all Jesus stands for to a saint, the Lord's instrument to spread the Gospel throughout the world. Certainly our Lord works in mysterious ways.


