A Message from Father Andrie

Sexual Integrity Sixth Commandment

This week we look at the sixth commandment as we continue our series on the Ten Commandments: *You shall not commit adultery* (Ex 20:14). In His Sermon on the Mount, Jesus raises the bar by saying, “*You have heard that it was said, ‘You shall not commit adultery.’ But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart*” (Mt 5:27-28).

In the Catholic Studies program at St. Thomas, I once had a professor who said that generally speaking, Jews tend to struggle with idolatry, while Gentiles struggle with sexual immorality. That comment remains with me as we look at the sixth commandment, which the tradition of the Church has understood as encompassing the whole of human sexuality (CCC 2336).

The Catholic Catechism begins discussion on this commandment by providing a helpful reflection on Christian anthropology. Drawing from the Book of Genesis, God created us male and female with the vocation to love (CCC 2331). That is, our relations with others, and in particular, our sexual relations should image God who is Love and Communion (since we are made in God’s image – Gn 1:26). In other words, as the archetype of love, God and His way of loving is the measure of human love.

Chastity is the virtue that enables you to love as God loves: a total love that is free, faithful, and fruitful. All the baptized are called to chastity. Priests and religious offer their sexuality to God alone, doing so with an undivided heart. Married spouses express their love for each other in many ways, including the marital act – the highest expression of their love. In the marital act, a husband and wife express with their bodies the vows they made to each other before God at the altar. The unmarried or engaged to be married, for their part, are called to strive for chastity and refrain from sexual relations so that they can grow in friendship, mutual respect, and heartfelt service to others.

The Catholic Catechism lists offenses against chastity: lust, masturbation, fornication, pornography, prostitution, and rape (CCC 2351-2356). Our sexuality is ordered to both **procreation** and **unity**. Lust, masturbation, and pornography are disconnected from procreation, while fornication, prostitution, and rape are offenses against unity. Offenses against chastity are contrary to the dignity of and respect owed to human persons.

The Catholic Catechism also speaks about homosexuality. Based on Sacred Scripture and the long tradition of the Church, it says that homosexual acts are intrinsically disordered and contrary to the natural law (CCC 2357). The Catechism reminds the faithful to demonstrate compassion and respect toward those wrestling with same-sex attraction. The good Lord will reward those who pray and offer sacrifices for those struggling in this area.

Naturally, the sixth commandment also concerns those married. The Catechism says that marital relations are not just biological, but also concern the innermost being of the human person as such (CCC 2361). That is, sexual relations in marriage are an expression of total self-giving (e.g., emotions, mind, heart, spirit, and fertility). In marital relations, a husband and wife not only share in the procreative power of God, but also express, deepen, renew their marriage vows and marital love for each other. Sexual love is an amazing gift from God. It not only has the capacity to create life, but also has tremendous power to unite the body, mind, heart, and spirit of spouses such that they image the love between Christ and His Bride, the Church.

The Catechism lists offenses against the dignity of marriage: adultery, divorce, polygamy, incest, free unions, and trial marriages (CCC 2380 – 2391). Adultery or marital infidelity is a grave sin in that it is a violation of the vow a spouse makes before God. Divorce, which has become quite common today, is contrary to the natural law (CCC 2384). Of course, there are many situations where one of the spouses has been abandoned or is an innocent victim of a divorce decreed by civil law. God has a special place in His heart for those who suffer unjustly in these challenging situations.

Polygamy, free unions, and trial marriages are contrary to the fidelity and total commitment that are essential to love. Such offenses are contrary to human dignity in that human beings are worthy of unconditional love, a love expressed perfectly by our Lord on the cross. Jesus always has been, is, and always will be the model for authentic love – self-giving love that is free, faithful, forgiving, and fruitful. By God’s grace, regular sacrifice, much prayer, and regular recourse to confession, may you strive to grow in chastity so that you can make a sincere gift of yourself to others each day.


Deacon John’s Corner

His Gifts – His Miracles

The readings this week point toward the Eucharist. The Gospel is the story of Jesus feeding over five thousand people with five loaves and two fish. We have heard this story so many times that we almost lose the enormity of this great miracle. In terms of miracles, this has to go down as one of the greatest - because it was witnessed by; and impacted so many people. Those who were present must have been amazed as to how Jesus could take such a small gift and grow it to sustain so many people.

Jesus was handed two fish and five loaves of bread and was able to create a great miracle. God can also take our natural talents and gifts and create so much more than we can do ourselves. Our God-given gifts can be multiplied (like the fish) if we only give our gifts back to God.




