

## A Message from Father Andrie

### Baptism, Eucharist, and Daily Life

Our Christmas celebration concludes with the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord. We began this beautiful time of the year with Advent as we reflected more deeply on Mary and Joseph, including their extraordinary virtues.

On Christmas, we looked at Mary and Joseph gazing upon the adorable and tender face of Jesus. In seeing the face of Jesus, they saw the face of God. On Christmas, we also celebrate that every face is an icon of Christ. In other words, now that God has a human face in Christ, each human face reflects the splendor of Christ, who is the face of God. For the person of faith, the beauty of Christ shines through each human face.



On Epiphany, we celebrated the way in which the Christ Child shined upon the three kings. Additionally, we looked at the way in which Mary and Joseph were impacted by this beautiful scene: three kings lying prostrate on the ground sliding their gifts before the child.

Today, we celebrate Jesus' baptism and His profound humility. Of course, we not only celebrate Jesus' baptism, but ours as well!

In the divine moment of Jesus' baptism, all three divine Persons are present. Obviously, Jesus is present. Additionally, the Father is present in the voice. "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." We hear this voice at Mass when the Scriptures are read. We hear this voice when we take time to pray. All of us want to hear those words, "You are my beloved child. I am very pleased with you."

The Spirit, too, is present in the form of a dove. The Spirit that created the world and re-created the world after Noah's flood is poured out upon Christ (and you!) in baptism. Each time you receive the Eucharist (in a state of grace), you receive an increase of the Holy Spirit.

When teaching about baptism to our little ones, I use short statements so they can remember the basics. I sometimes say, "Sin out. God in. In the Church." All sin is wiped away, both original and personal. God in. The Holy Spirit or God's own life is given to us. And in the Church. We are brought into the Church, or the community of faith, where we worship God together, support each other, and serve in Christ's name. We are brought into the Church, i.e., baptism and the Eucharist are tied together. The two always go together like a hand and a glove.

There is another tie as well. Baptism and Eucharist are tied with daily life. We receive the Eucharist on Sunday and all the graces of the Eucharist, and extend or share them with others the other six days of the week. There are few things sadder than a Catholic who doesn't put into practice the graces received at Mass.

We could call living our faith daily "Eucharist in Action." We put the "Eucharist in Action" by the way we live. One of the ways we do this is by seeing Jesus in the poor, the weak, and the vulnerable. In the month of January, we focus on the gift of life and celebrate life at all stages – from the womb to our elderly who are in need of our care and love.

During this month, I invite you to pray for a greater recognition of the gift of life. We have been extremely blessed by God as a parish, both naturally and supernaturally. Let's keep those connections strong – Baptism, Eucharist, and Daily Life (or Eucharist in Action). Allow God's love to flow from the Eucharist through you to others every day.



Deacon John’s Note

The Patience of the Holy Spirit

This weekend we celebrate the end of the Christmas season. Many of you have most likely taken down your Christmas decorations a while ago. After this weekend the Church will shift its focus to what we call “ordinary time.” In this week’s Gospel, John the Baptist baptizes Jesus in the river Jordan. Jesus’ baptism begins our Lord’s public ministry, which lasted just over 3 years. We might say that the baptism of Jesus was the launching point of His saving ministry. After His baptism, Jesus began to preach to those who would listen, He healed the sick, gave sight to the blind and freed those who were imprisoned by sin.



The Holy Spirit descended down on Jesus. His baptism became his spiritual nourishment. We too receive the grace of that same Holy Spirit when we are baptized. Of course, most of us were probably babies when we were baptized. So, we didn’t likely understand the powerful gift of the Holy Spirit that we received at the time of our baptisms. The good news is that the Holy Spirit patiently waits for us to grow up to understand and take advantage of this great gift. We can call on the gift of the Holy Spirit at any time in our lifetime. Even if we spent most of our lives in sin and rejecting God, the Holy Spirit is still waiting for us. In fact, the Holy Spirit will wait for us until we take our final breath on earth. It is through the work of the Holy Spirit where we grow in our faith, which enables our eternal salvation.

Thank God for the patience of the Holy Spirit!






