A Message from Father Andrie

Can I Get a Witness?

Many blessings to you and your families as we celebrate the Resurrection of Christ, who is our great hope and our great love.

Many of you likely have seen southern Baptist worship services that can be most lively. In moments of great jubilation, the minister says, “Can I get a witness?” “Amen, brother! We praise you, Jesus!” Can I get a witness? In our first reading, Peter says not once, but twice that he is a witness to all that Jesus said and did.

Christ radically transformed the spunky fisherman from Galilee. When Christ encountered Peter, he was doing what he always did, i.e., fishing. This little Rabbi from Nazareth told Peter to put out into the deep water for a catch of fish.

After a big catch, Peter followed Jesus and listened attentively to His words. Peter witnessed Jesus’ miracles (e.g., healing the sick, casting out demons, and raising people from the dead). Peter was there in the commotion of the Garden of Gethsemane on Holy Thursday. Today, with John, Peter sees the empty tomb. And as we just heard, he ate and drank with the Risen Christ.

Peter, frightened during Jesus’ arrest, now becomes courageous in proclaiming that Jesus is risen. He is willing to suffer ridicule, to be imprisoned and beaten for the truth that Jesus lives. According to tradition, Peter was crucified upside down in Rome, feeling unworthy to die as his Lord and Master. He bore witness for Christ to the end.

Throughout the centuries, God has given the Church thousands and thousands of saints – men, women, young, old, single, married, priests, and religious – with different ethnic and economic backgrounds who have borne witness to the infinite love of Christ.

St. Monica: The mother of Augustine, never gave up on her son but shed tears for his conversion. God saw her tears and converted her son who became one of the greatest saints in the Church.

St. Maria Goretti: Just 11 years old, offered her life to God, preferring to die rather than have her purity violated.

St. John Bosco: Evangelized youth through juggling and games, and became a spiritual father to those who lost their parents.

St. Philip Neri: Reformed the Church in Rome in the sixteenth century through his sense of humor and passion for Christ.

St. Teresa of Avila: Reformed the Carmelite order through her spunkiness, charm, tenacity, and love for Christ.

St. Thérèse: Reminded her sisters that you reveal Christ’s love by doing little things with great love. By becoming little, Jesus can pick you up in His arms.

Saints Louis and Zélie Martin: The parents of St. Thérèse were witnesses to the Resurrection of Jesus in keeping God at the center of their family life through their acts of generosity, devotions, and self-sacrifices for one other.

St. Mother Teresa: Although just 5’ feet tall, she was a *giant* in the way of love in serving the poorest of the poor.

Blessed Carlo Acutis: Born in 1991 and gifted in technology, built his own website with pictures of Eucharistic miracles around the world at age 11. The first millennial “tech teen” who passed away at age 15 reminds us that teenagers, too, can be saints!

Can I get a witness? In every age, God gives His Church saints who bear witnesses to the extraordinary love of Jesus Christ, and the great joy of serving Him in His Church.

The question is: will *you* be a witness? God does not choose extraordinary people, but ordinary people like you to do extraordinary things by His grace and His love. He wants to use your personality, your strengths, your weaknesses, your gifts, and your heart to witness that Jesus Christ is risen from the dead. Be a witness that Jesus Christ is risen and that life with Him is a great adventure!

Jesus is Risen!



As I have said before: it’s a *great time* to be a saint! It’s a great time to be a witness! Thousands and thousands of ordinary men and women down the centuries have done it. And *you* can too! Be a witness for Jesus Christ risen from the dead by your words, joy, hope, and generous love. Christ is Risen! Happy Easter! ~St. Thérèse, pray for us!

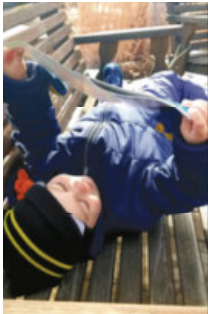

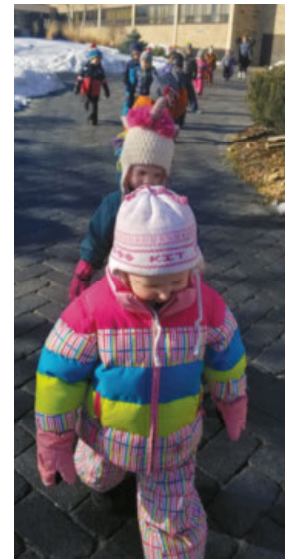
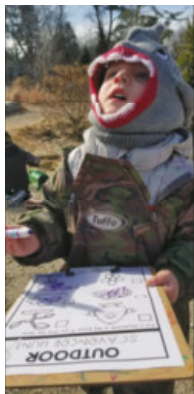


Early Learning Center

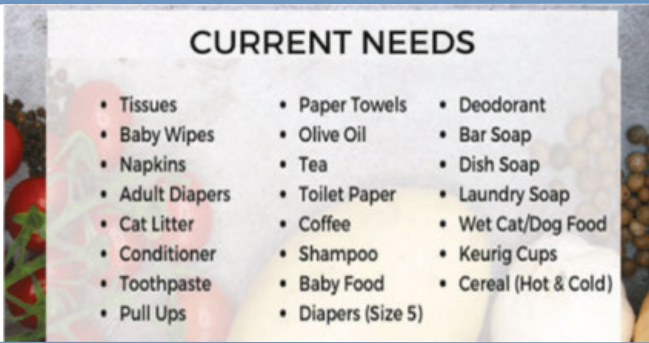
