

#### Know Your Catholic Faith

#### Presbyterate

The Church is the People of God (according to the Dogmatic Constitution on the Church) who engage in a variety of ministries. All human beings, by their Baptism, share in the ministry of Christ as prophet, priest, and king. Ministry means service. The People of God applies equally to the laity, religious, and clergy. In the early church there existed not only many different types of ministry but also different ways in which individuals exercised these ministries. These ministries may be viewed in two broad strokes: a missionary ministries which apostles, prophets, and teachers exercised, and residential ministries which presbyters exercised in Jewish-Christian communities and bishops and deacons exercised in Gentile-Christian communities. The Holy Orders of the Presbyterate, or ordained priesthood, along with the Episcopate and Diaconate are ministries and states-in-life who are called out of and set aside for the work of the Church. In contemporary Catholic theology, the ordained ministry is one of service, leadership and preaching the word. (11:10)



#### EASE FUND GUIDELINES

Dear Parishioners,

The Assumption Parish is pleased to provide you with information regarding the guidelines for the Endowing Assumption Students with Education (EASE) Fund.

Father Terry Lees established the EASE Fund in the 1980's and has been maintained to provide tuition assistance to Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary families for Catholic Education.

The EASE fund is made available to any qualifying student who seeks a secure K–12 Catholic education at an accredited elementary or high school located within the Diocese of Des Moines.

The application period opens the first business day of February and will close the first business day of April. The award-notification letters of financial assistance will be sent by May 15<sup>th</sup>.

The amount awarded to a qualifying family in any given year will be \$300 per elementary student and \$500 per high school student, as long as the total distribution is within the limit of total funding available. The amount of total funding available for disbursement to all qualifying applicants in any given fiscal year shall not exceed 5% of the EASE fund balance at the end of the prior fiscal year.
