

MSP TIP FOR THE PHONE APP

Did you know that if you wanted to sign-up for an open position for an upcoming Mass on the Ministry Scheduler Pro (MSP) APP, you just need to:

1. Download and install the APP to your phone.
2. Open the MSP APP on your phone and enter the Organization ID: *NativityFargo*.
3. Enter your web terminal username and password.
4. On the bottom, tap on 'Open Positions'
5. Black dates are open dates. Gold/brown dates are dates that a sub has been requested.
6. Tap on the date you would like to minister.
7. Tap on 'Volunteer Now' and enter in the position you would like to volunteer for in the "Your Comments" box.
8. Tap Submit Assignment Request.
9. Your request will go directly on the calendar.

PASTOR'S NOTES

Pope Francis recently instituted the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, to be observed each year on the fourth Sunday of July, which is next Sunday. The Pastoral Guidelines issued by the Vatican Dicastery for Laity, Family & Life speak to the impetus to begin this observation: "The decision to hold a World Day for Grandparents and Older People has come at a time marked by a pandemic and by the suffering of our older generations in recent months in every part of the world. Reports of elderly people having to die alone and then not even being given a funeral, have been a cause of deep pain to the Church." Pope Francis chose as its theme "I am with you always" (Mt 28:20), the words of Jesus to his disciples before he ascended into heaven, to express that "every ecclesial community wishes to be with the elderly always," now and in the future. In his message to grandfathers and grandmothers, Pope Francis reflects on his election as Pope at what he calls "retirement age," noting that God, who is eternal, "never, ever goes into retirement" and "is close to us with new possibilities, new ideas, new consolations, but always close to us." He speaks to the vocation of those of his age "to preserve our roots, to pass on the faith to the young and to care for the little ones." There is no retirement age in proclaiming the Gospel! Citing his most recent encyclical, *Fratelli Tutti*, Pope Francis reflects on the truth that "no one is saved alone," and so grandparents "are needed in order to help build, in fraternity and social friendship, the world of tomorrow," for they are the best equipped to set up the three pillars that support this world: dreams, memory, and prayer. He cites the promise found in the prophet Joel (3:1): "Your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men will have visions." To dream dreams of justice, of peace, and of solidarity "can make it possible for our young people to have new visions." It is crucial to keep memory alive as the foundation "to build a more humane and welcoming world." Regarding prayer, he cites Pope Benedict, who said in 2012: "The prayer of the elderly can protect the world, helping it perhaps more effectively than the frenetic activity of many others." The Pastoral Guidelines mentioned above reflect on the readings for next weekend. St. Paul writes in his Letter to the Ephesians that we are "one body and one Spirit, as you were also called to the one hope of your call." Whatever our age, whether or not we belong to the same biological family, we are all part of the family of God. In the Gospel, Jesus feeds the five thousand with just the five barley loaves and two fish a boy brings him. This "helps us to understand how, even in everyday family life, whatever each of us possesses can be a great resource for all of us," and serves as an encouragement "to multiply the faith and wisdom of the elderly. In their spiritual depth there is a treasure to be discovered." I invite you next weekend to pray the prayer found on this page, and to take some time to reflect on your grandparents and, if they are still living, to contact them.

Parable of Lost Sheep ~ Sister Sharon Houle

Who among you having a hundred sheep, losing one of them would not leave the ninety-nine and go after the lost one? Upon finding it, would joyfully set it on your shoulder and take it home? Upon arriving at home, call friends and neighbors and say, "Rejoice with me because I have found the lost sheep." "I tell you, in just the same way there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who have no need of repentance." Luke 15:3-7.

Jesus eats with tax collectors and sinners; they are the lost sheep. The Pharisees and teachers of the law do not like it. At the same time, Jesus is witnessing to them how much he cares for those outside the fold. The Pharisees are blind to it. Jesus tells them it is not the sheep within the fold that he needs to find: it is the ones who are not in the fold. Jesus came to seek and save those who are lost. When the lost are found it is a time to rejoice. Luke 15:7 says there is more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over the ninety-nine righteous who need not repent.

God celebrates when a lost soul is found. This is why Jesus came; this is what salvation is all about. Jesus was able to endure the cross because of the joy set before him. The joy set before Jesus was all the lost sheep, you and me, who would repent and be reunited with him and the Father. The crown of the cross is your life and mine that God has redeemed. This is the reason for the greatest of celebrations in heaven. Hebrews 12:2. St. Catherine of Siena said: "Jesus is so madly in love with us sinners that He ran to embrace the Cross." He willingly gave Himself over to suffering to rescue the lost.

We are all sheep who have been found and gathered up by the mercy of God. We are also called by Jesus to shepherd one another, to gather those who have strayed, so that there will be one flock and one shepherd. Let us not give up on those who have wandered from the faith, who are not currently in the fold. Pray for them, search them out, love them. This is what Jesus desires; it is the will of the Father. Let us find the lost sheep and celebrate with heaven their return.
