



### The Angelus Prayer Honor Mary, the Mother of God

Catholics pray the Angelus in the morning, at Noon, and in the evening. The Angelus pays tribute to a crucial aspect of Mary's role in the Incarnation, when it quotes from Luke's Gospel "be it done to me according to thy word" (Lk 1:38). This wonderful event could not have happened without her consent, without what is known as her fiat. By saying "yes" to God in allowing herself to become His mother, she showed us the ultimate example of trust in our Creator!

*The Angel of the Lord declared to Mary:*

*And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.*

*Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.*

*Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.*

*Behold the handmaid of the Lord:*

*Be it done unto me according to Thy word.*

*Hail Mary...*

*And the Word was made Flesh: And dwelt among us.*

*Hail Mary...*

*Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God, that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.*

*Let us pray: Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts; that we, to whom the incarnation of Christ, Thy Son, was made known by the message of an angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection, through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen.*

### Reflection for the Solemnity of Pentecost

~Catholicism Pure and Simple

The Solemnity of Pentecost is a splendid reminder of the universality of the love God has for us. At Pentecost, fifty days after Easter, the Church celebrates the powerful presence of God in our midst through the gifts of the Holy Spirit, poured out upon the people of God in ages past and to the present day. The traditional list of the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit is derived from Isaiah the Prophet, chapter 11, verses 1 - 3: wisdom, understanding, knowledge, counsel, piety, fortitude and fear of the Lord.

In essence, Pentecost Sunday recounts the outpouring of these gifts by the Holy Spirit on the apostles and other disciples and the Mother of Jesus ten days after the Ascension of Jesus and 50 days after his resurrection. This is traditionally considered the beginning of the Church, the birthday of the Church.

Christians believe that salvation history culminates in the Incarnation of Jesus Christ, acknowledged as the Redeemer of the human race. **All that Christ promised during his public ministry was fulfilled at Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit was given to the disciples so that they could go forth and bear witness to the mystery of life and salvation in God.**

At Pentecost people of diverse tongues unite. They come to realize that they are all in essence equal to each other, meaning everyone is eligible for receiving life in God and of being in communion with God and one another.

The grace of God produces unity and the disciples of Jesus experience this concretely at Pentecost with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. "God is a God, not of confusion, but of peace," Saint Paul reminds the believers at Corinth (1 Corinthians 14:33).




## Living Mercy

## Celebration of Beauty & Hope: June 13, 3:00 pm

### Part II: Charles Callahan, Composer ~Dr. Marie Rubis Bauer

Art can lead us to faith. Faith can lead us to art. I'm always captivated by the stories of Medieval gothic churches and cathedrals, and the intentional way in which these grand, transcendent buildings lead our thoughts to God, and at the same time, plant God within us. The function of the stories in the windows of stained glass have always had the pastoral goal of serving as a doorway to faith. Stories can be told with or without word - maybe in gestures and dancing, maybe in colors and shapes, maybe in melodies and harmonies. All of these lead us directly, and sometimes subtly to God. Circle to the first half of the 20th Century on a hill in Omaha, Nebraska, I am moved to tears of the story of the very workers of the cathedral - locals who hoisted beams, carried bricks, installed lighting and pews, found it within themselves to give their money - all together - to tell stories of faith through beauty and light in the windows of our own Saint Cecilia Cathedral.



On June 13 we will be celebrating signs of Beauty and Hope, including the **premier of a new work by lauded American Composer, Charles Callahan.**

This work, the Saint Cecilia Organbook, draws upon the windows and their chants and is rooted in a lifetime of liturgical musical immersion in worship as a church musician and a composer of inspiring song. Charles Callahan's music is simple, direct, and profound. This is the context of the Saint Cecilia Organbook, and we look forward to introducing 12 miniature movements in order to bring us all closer to the great stories and melodies of faith found in our windows.

Secondly, on the same program **we will introduce John Derry, photographer and his work,** inspired by the art of the play of light on the cathedral windows, and faith of our Patron, Saint Cecilia.

Finally, because all of this would be 'a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal' to quote Saint Paul, if it didn't lead us to our most important mission: to love our neighbor. So the third part of this celebration will be to **highlight an important ministry of hope, through the Food Pantry at the Cathedral,** led by parishioners in the Saint Vincent De Paul Society and Knights of Columbus. This important ministry is ongoing, and it always needs and welcomes the support in the donation of food an financial support. Please join us for this special celebration, and bring food or gift cards to help our parish minister in a special way to those in need. Next week we will meet the faces behind the scenes of the Food Pantry ministry.




