

## WE ARE NOW OPEN!

New Melleray Abbey is located in the fertile farmlands and rugged woodlands twelve miles southwest of Dubuque, IA. Guests are welcome to visit the monastery and share in our daily liturgy from Vigils at 3:30 am all the way through to Compline at 7:30 pm. Through our liturgy, gift shop, guest house, and monastic center we offer hospitality to all who come to New Melleray whether it be for a few minutes of prayer or several days of a personal or *themed* retreat. Additionally, visitors are encouraged to visit and take a tour of Trappist Caskets where we produce the handcrafted caskets that are our primary form of manual labor and self-support.

#### RETREATS

The monastery is a place where we learn to love God, to love ourselves, and to love each other. The abbey provides for retreats on the grounds for the layperson. A retreat can be personal and provide an opportunity to step out of the ordinary routine into an environment where time and energy can be focused on God. Making a personal retreat at the monastery provides an opportunity to follow the monastic schedule with its emphasis on prayer, study and reflection. We leave the monastery feeling spiritually refreshed, taking with us a deeper understanding of how we can follow the monastic way as we live in the world. Throughout the year, the monastery offers various retreats that focus on a particular topic or theme, or are intended for a particular group of people.

## St. Peter Canisius | Feast Day December 21

Born in Holland, St. Peter Canisius (May 8, 1521 – December 21, 1597) was a preacher, teacher, and writer throughout his whole life. At the age of 19, he received a master's degree from the university at Cologne. Soon afterwards, St. Peter met Peter Faber, the first disciple of Ignatius of Loyola, who influenced him so much that he eventually joined the Society of Jesus.

St. Peter Canisius founded colleges and seminaries, served as a missionary, cared for the sick or imprisoned, and wrote close to eight volumes of letters — many about St. Cyril of Alexandria and St. Leo the Great.

A man blessed with many talents, St. Peter Canisius is a wonderful example of a man who developed his talents to further God's work here on earth. ©LPi
