

Notes from Father Nick...

To our high school seniors: "Applications for the Marguerite Ritzinger Scholarship of the Diocese of Davenport are being accepted through Feb. 15, 2022. Catholic individuals who plan to attend a college or university next fall may apply for a \$1,000 scholarship. Nontraditional students may apply for the scholarships. The award is named for the late Marguerite Ritzinger, a Sigourney native, who left \$388,770 to the diocese to help with scholarships for seminarians and students attending colleges or universities. Applications must include an essay, copy of a high school or college transcript and two reference letters. All items must be sent together with the application form, which is available on the diocesan website at https://www.davenportdiocese.org in the Quick Links section of the homepage."

I will be resuming our Adult Education Series, "Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible," on these Tuesday evenings: January 25; February 1; February 8 and February 22. These sessions will be held in our Parish Social Hall, beginning at 6:30 pm. All are welcome!

As you may have been reading in *The Catholic Messenger*, Pope Francis has called for a World-wide *Synod* from 2021-2023. Its theme is "Journeying Together-Communion, Participation, Mission." "Synod" is not a familiar word for most Catholics. It's a Greek word, basically meaning to "walk with," or "journey together." Throughout our history, it's been used to refer to gatherings of the Church to "walk with" one another and with the Holy Spirit, to read "the signs of the times" and discern in a spirit of prayer how the Church is being called to respond.

Bishop Zinkula is asking for our participation in this synod. You are invited to do so by answering two simple questions. "'How is this "journeying together" happening today in your local Church?" and "What steps does the Spirit invite us to take in order to grow in our "journeying together?" In light of this church effort, I offer our diocesan prayer for our synod.

We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name.

With You alone to guide us,

make Yourself at home in our hearts;

Teach us the way we must go

and how we are to pursue it.

We are weak and sinful;

do not let us promote disorder.

Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions.

Let us find in You our unity

so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth

and what is right.

All this we ask of You,

who are at work in every place and time in the communion of the Father and the Son,
