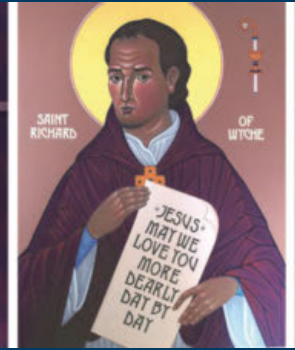

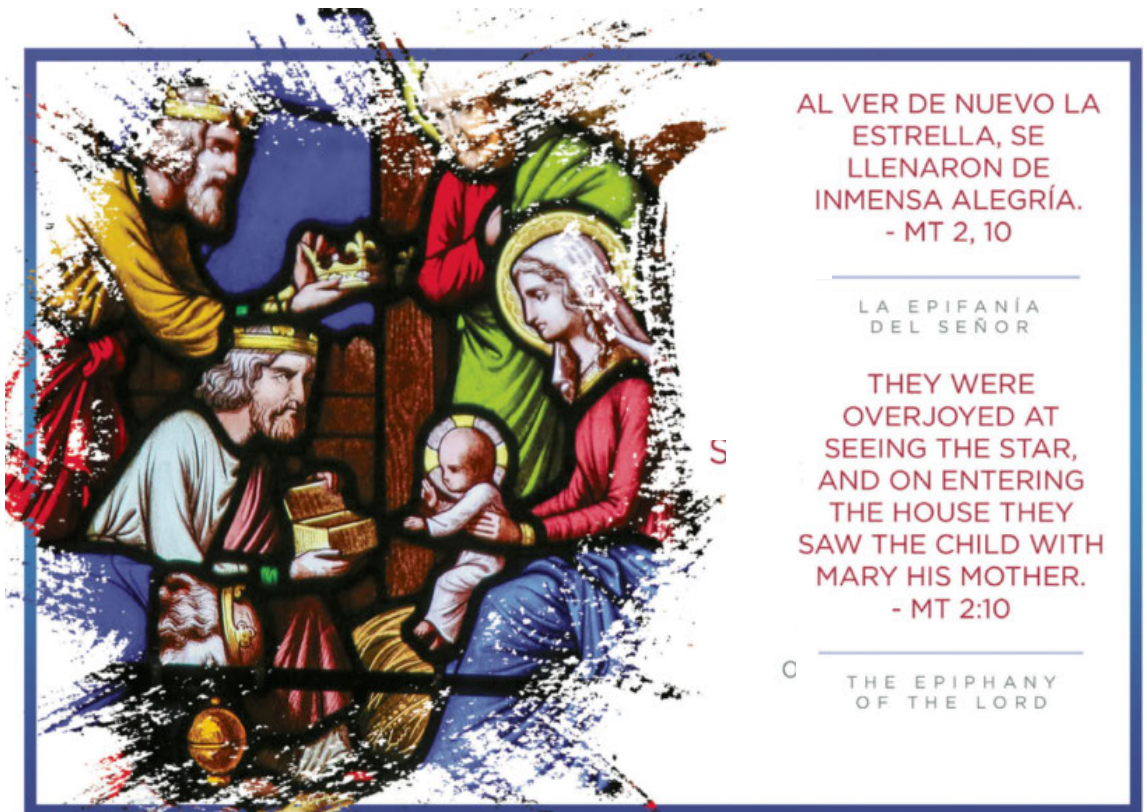

March for Life Jan. 22

Minnesota Citizens Concerned for Life will host its annual March for Life on Saturday, Jan. 22 -- the 49th anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court's Roe v. Wade decision. -- on the grounds of the state capitol in St. Paul. The march will commemorate the tens of millions of lives that have been lost and the number of women and men who have been wounded. The purpose of the rally is to "... send the message that both unborn children and their mothers deserve protection, support and love -- that all human beings, no matter their age or their size, have human rights." The march is scheduled for noon, and will be followed by a brief program at 12:30 p.m.

El propósito de la manifestación es "... enviar el mensaje de que tanto los niños no nacidos como sus madres merecen protección, apoyo y amor, que todos los seres humanos, sin importar su edad o su tamaño, tienen derechos humanos". La marcha está prevista para el mediodía, y será seguida por un breve programa a las 12:30 p.m.

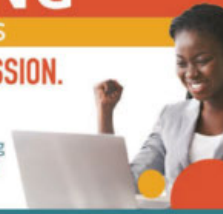
