COVID-19 INFORMATION

The obligation to attend Mass is abrogated (lifted) until further notice. **Anyone who feels unwell or unsafe should not attend Mass at this time.**

All St. Lawrence liturgies are scheduled to be live-streamed through YouTube and Facebook. The St. Lawrence chapel will be OPEN 10am-3pm 7 days a week.

Everyone attending is obliged to the following:

- Everyone must disinfect/wash their hands upon entering the chapel.
- No more than 175 people may occupy the chapel at a time. The doors will be locked if capacity is reached.
- Groups in close proximity to one another limited to 45 persons. As much as possible, six feet of distance is to be maintained between persons not of the same household. Physical contact with other persons is to be minimized at all times.
- Each person is responsible for spraying disinfectant on any surface touched using the supplies available before leaving the chapel.

Holy Communion will be distributed in the St. Lawrence parking lot at 12:15pm on Sundays for anyone who is unable to attend Mass in person.

Additional Recommendations:

- facial coverings/masks except for the moment of receiving Holy Communion
- gloves and personal sanitizer
- communion in the hand

Additional Information:

- Baptisms, Funerals and Weddings may be celebrated using these same guidelines.
