## We're so glad you're here,





## Welcome to Sacred Heart Catholic Church



## Reflect on the Word

**First Reading:** Early in their Exodus journey, the Israelites expressed fear and frustration to Moses. God heard and responded to their “grumbling” by sending bread from heaven. When you have you experienced God answering your plea for help?

**Second Reading:** Paul told the Ephesians that as believers in Christ you should “put away” the bad parts of “your former way of life.” How have you done this in your life as a believer in Christ?

**Gospel:** We hear today the introduction of Jesus’ extended “bread of life” discourse. In referring back to the ancient Israelites who ate “manna” (bread) in the desert, Jesus tells the crowds: “I am the bread of life.” How would you explain to someone how Jesus sustains you?

## The Transfiguration of the Lord - August 6

“O God, Who in the glorious transfiguration of Thine only-begotten Son didst strengthen the sacraments of faith by the testimony of the fathers, and Who didst wonderfully fore show the perfect adoption of Thy children by a voice coming down in a shining cloud, mercifully grant that we be made co-heirs of the King of glory Himself, and grant us to be sharers in that very glory. Through the same Lord Jesus Christ, Thy Son, Who liveth and reigneth with Thee in the unity of the Holy Ghost, God, world without end.  
Amen.”

The feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord Jesus Christ celebrates the revelation of Christ’s divine glory on Mount Tabor in Galilee (Matthew 17:1-6; Mark 9:1-8; Luke 9:28-36). After revealing to His disciples that He would be put to death in Jerusalem (Matthew 16:21), Christ, along with Ss. Peter, James, and John went up the mountain. There, Saint Matthew writes, “he was transfigured before them. And his face did shine as the sun: and his garments became white as snow.”

## The RCIA Process Begins Soon and You are Invited

Are you feeling called to come fully into the Catholic Church?

Sitting at Mass as a faith-filled person who is not Catholic can feel like being invited to a feast, but only to observe, not to fully partake. It seems like the Church is being exclusive rather than inclusive. In reality, the Eucharist is the source and summit of all that we Catholics believe. It is sacred, it unifies us and it calls us to believe all that is connected with it.

Therefore, we invite you to consider “all that is connected with it”— the teachings of the Catholic Church—and see if indeed, you discern you are called to become Catholic. If you are hungry to know more, we have a process just for you called Inquiry. Inquiry is a time of questioning, defined as ‘an act of asking for information’. During this period of Inquiry, your questions about the Church, its beliefs and practices will be answered.

We will be holding an **Information Night on August 31 from 7:00-8:30 p.m. in Meeting Rooms 1 and 2 to explain the RCIA process more fully.** We will meet each Tuesday evening from 6:30-8:30 pm , September through April. ## Everyday Stewardship *Recognize God in your Everyday Moments*

### Practicing Graciousness in the Desert

Looking back over my journey of parenthood, I know there were days when I traveled the extra mile for my children. I made their toast the way they like it, let them play in the park an extra ten minutes, or let them go to the movies with their friends and I finished up the chores on my own. And then, it happened: the attitude. The request for the smallest thing from one of them is met with disdain or bewilderment.

Sometimes you can be made breathless with the ingratitude of another person who takes so much and with so little shame, only to scoff at the idea that they, too, give even the smallest amount.

But if we're being honest with ourselves, we will admit that we do the exact same thing to God. Haven't we all been the Israelites in the desert at one point or another? God has parted our Red Sea in some way. He's led us out of some great trial, given us some great blessings. But then we run into a little resistance somewhere along the way and we throw up our hands. How could you do this to us, Lord? How could you ask this of us? No, I can't go any further. No, I won't do any more. Persisting in the blindness to the many ways God continues to protect us is nothing short of a temper tantrum. It robs our Everyday Stewardship of its graciousness, of our ability to accept with joy the trials of life because we are also constantly aware of its blessings.

**Question:** What are the requirements for being a confirmation sponsor?



**Answer:**

Although many dioceses have specific requirements for who can be a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, the Code of Canon Law identifies certain requirements that are true for all dioceses and parishes. First, the sponsor should be chosen by the one to be confirmed (or, in some cases, by the parents or even the pastor). Second, a sponsor must be at least sixteen years old (unless the local bishop has chosen another age, or a special exception has been made). Third, the sponsor must be a Catholic who has been confirmed and who has already received the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Beyond this, they must lead “a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on.” Fourth, they can have no sort of canonical penalty or impediment. Finally, they cannot be either the father or mother of the one to be confirmed (See Canons 893, §1 and 874, §1).




