God created humanity for greatness and calls each of us to continually grow



We remember those we love who are not with us today, but who remain with us in spirit.





### Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA) at Sacred Heart

Have you noticed our RCIA Catechumens being dismissed after the homily at our 9:30 Masses? They are dismissed before the Liturgy of the Eucharist begins as they must await their baptism which will join them to God's priestly people and empower them to fully participate in the Eucharistic Feast! This dismissal takes place starting at the Rite of Welcome/Acceptance and



runs until the Easter Vigil when our Catechumens receive their long awaited Sacraments. The dismissal is a special time for our Catechumens and a member of the RCIA Leadership Team – it is a time of reflection, prayer and faith sharing that flows from the Word of God. After our Catechumens are dismissed, all the baptized have specific duties to fulfill as the Mass continues.

The baptized roles include: 1) Proclaim the Creed – don't just recite it, if you believe it, then proclaim it! 2) Pray for the world by participating in the Prayers of the Faithful – listen to these beautiful prayers and all that the Catholic Church is collectively praying for 3) Offer your very self during the Eucharistic Prayers 4) You are called to mission at the end of each Mass with the words of dismissal "Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord." You must share with others how good our God is! We all have our roles within the Universal Church – how are we each fulfilling those roles?



### Everyday Stewardship Recognize God in your Everyday Moments

There is a lot of imagery around Christmas that has to do with adoption — or, more specifically, with a child being loved by another as if they belonged to that person and loved in such a profound way that in time, they do come to belong to that person. We see this with Joseph and the infant Jesus. Joseph is not Jesus' biological father. But through a series of actions, and through his faithfulness in small, everyday matters, Joseph becomes the foster father of Jesus. Perhaps we are parents who have adopted children, or we ourselves were adopted. We have also seen how, through a series of actions of love and sacrifice, someone can become the parent of a person who is not their "blood." A lot of times these families celebrate the day of the adoption. I've heard it called a "gotcha day," and it's marked joyously, like a birthday. Most of us are not descended from the Israelites, God's Chosen People. But through a series of extraordinary actions of love and sacrifice, God has made Himself our parent, too. And through our own actions, and through faithfulness in small and everyday matters, we are His children.

But in this family, instead of blood ties, we have stewardship ties. It's not about who we look like, it's about how we treat one another. How we take care of one another.

So this Christmas, let's think about how we will celebrate our adoption. As much as it is Jesus' birthday, it's also our "gotcha day" — the day we received the gift of eternal family.
