We're so glad you're here!



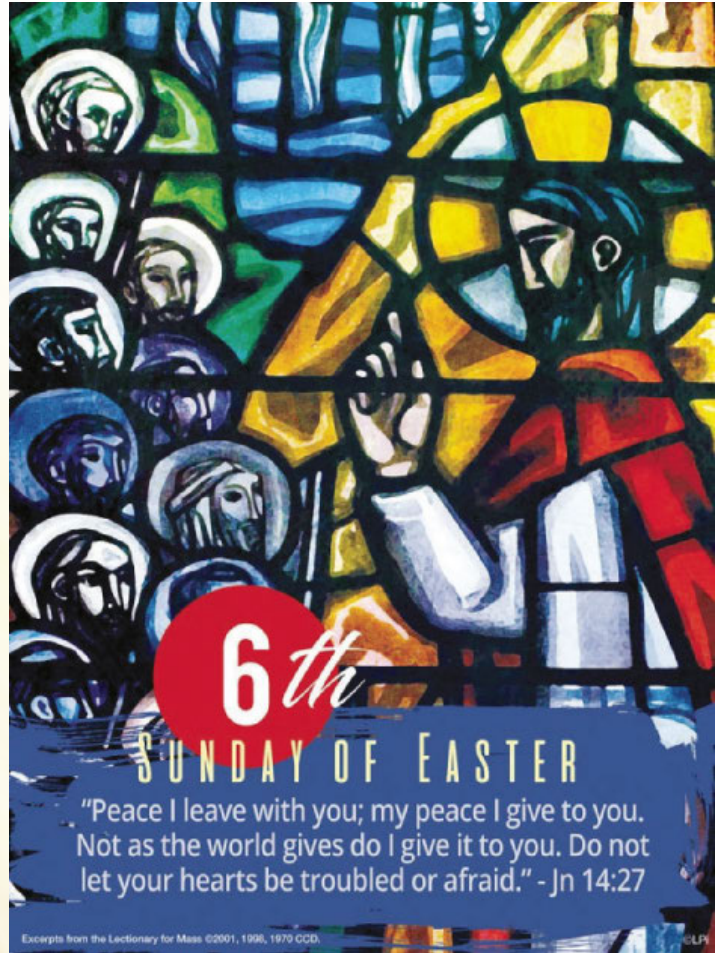

Live the Liturgy *Inspiration for the Week*

Everyone wants to experience peace. When we look to the world to provide this for us, we can easily get disappointed. 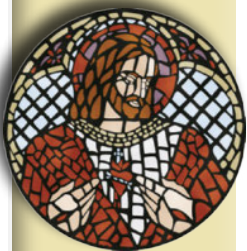

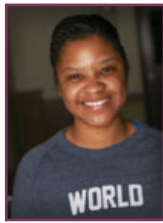

MaKayla's Experience - RCIA



1. What brought you to RCIA?

My husband is catholic and it was important to him that we raise our kids catholic. We went through marriage prep with Father Pat and I told him that I wanted to get baptized. Father Pat told me to wait until I was sure if I wanted to join the Catholic Church. When the time came, I wanted to learn more and get my questions answered about the church... Little did I know I would completely fall in love with it.



2. What was your experience through this year's RCIA process?

This process has been so beautiful. Not only do you get the feeling of out pouring love and affection from the leaders and RCIA community, but the teaching about the Catholic Church is like no other. There is no pressure and the topics are not forced upon you. They are taught in a way that truly gets your mind thinking and allows you to ask questions freely. I have always wanted to go to a church and feel like I am "at home". Through the RCIA process, I have accomplished that and more! I truly feel more peaceful in my life being more connected to Our Father.

3. What was your biggest surprise/Aha moment about the Catholic Church?

I think the biggest surprise is learning that all the misconceptions that are constantly filled in our minds about the Catholic Church are far from the truth. It is actually one of the most welcoming religions that I have come to know.

4. What would you say to someone who is considering joining or returning to the Catholic faith through the RCIA process?

If you are curious at all, do not hesitate, just come to the first couple sessions. Hear the message, meet the leaders and dedicated sponsors. Trust your instinct and allow Jesus to enter your life. I promise, you won't be disappointed.

Saint of the Week, St. Rita of Cascia *Feast Day is May 22*



St. Rita of Cascia (1381 – 1457) had the opportunity to live her life as a wife, mother, widow, and eventually, member of a religious community. Born in central Italy, St. Rita felt the calling to become a nun, but was pressured at a young age into marriage. During her 18-year marriage to a cruel man, she raised two sons. When her husband was killed in a brawl and her sons died, St. Rita decided to go back to her first love and attempted to join the Augustinian nuns in Cascia. Her status as a widow caused some complications to her entering, but she eventually succeeded in professing vows.

Throughout her lifetime, St. Rita of Cascia was known for her prayerfulness and charity. She also experienced stigmata on her forehead, meditated frequently on Christ's passion, and cared for the nuns of her religious community and those in the lay community who came to her for counsel.

Catholic Q&A



Question: I can't explain it. I feel a nudge from God to something out of the ordinary. How do I respond?

Answer: You're in good company! Abraham was asked to leave all he knew and loved for a strange land, with only abstract divine assurance that such a sacrifice would be worth it. Plenty of prophets protested against God's call, whether it was claiming they were too young (Jeremiah) or running away entirely, only to end up in a whale's belly (Jonah). St. Joseph was asked to do something very strange. He was asked to believe — on the word of an angelic appearance in a dream — that his betrothed was pregnant not from another man, but by a miraculous intervention of God. Then he was called to marry her.

Author Flannery O'Connor once wrote, "You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you odd." Sometimes God's invitation might seem strange or challenging. It might require sacrifices we never expected to make. Our life might look different than we had always imagined. But as we all know, life throws its own curveballs, regardless of whether or not we're listening for God's will. Better, one would think, to be open to the promptings of God and to follow along the strange trails that they lead. We have the assurance that, eventually, we will find green pastures.
