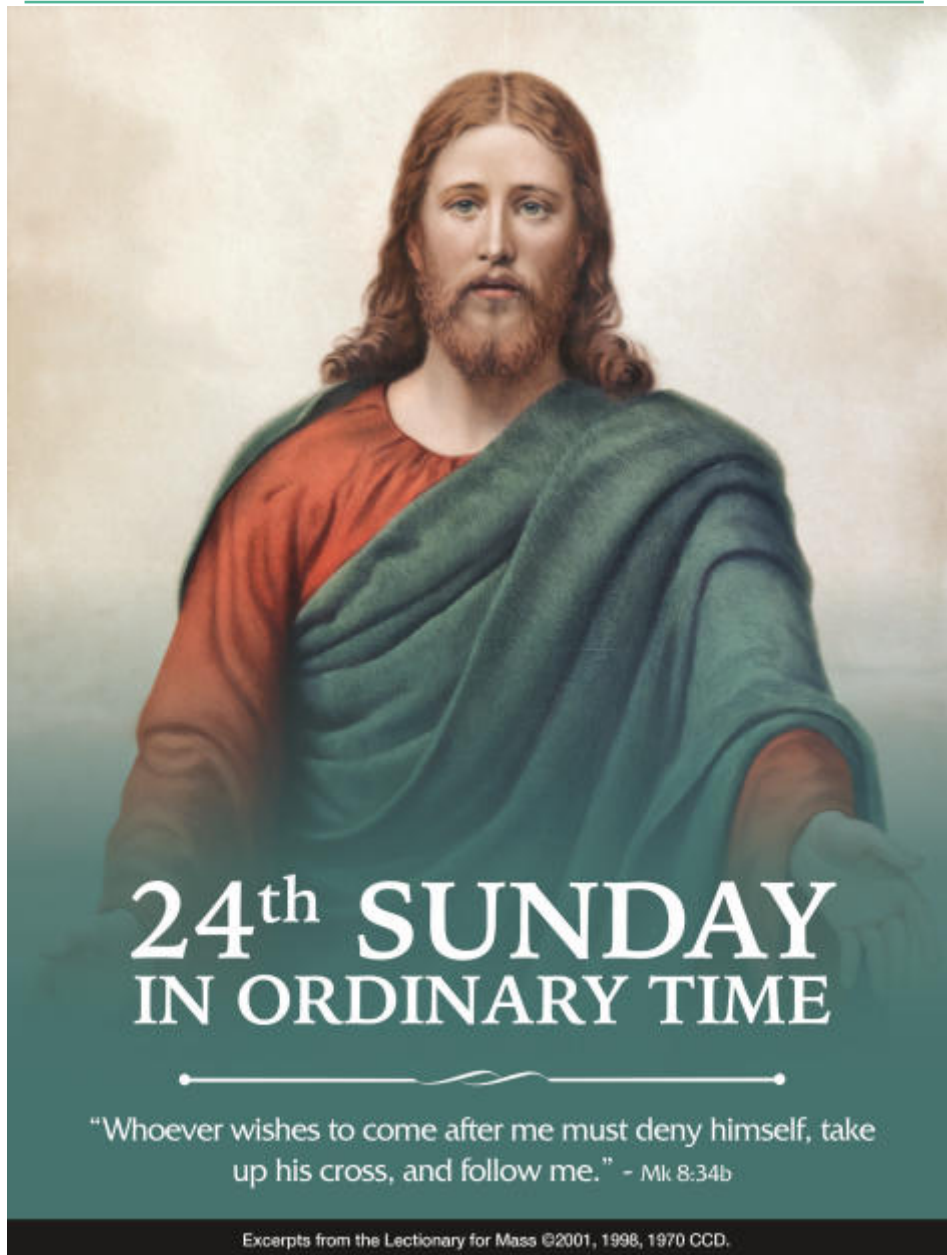

Being a good listener is a vital part of living our dignity as Christians. Jesus is an attentive and available listener to all who seek him. Because our marriages imitate Christ's love for the Church, we are called to generously listen to our spouse. How do we do this?

- Be available: prioritize listening to your spouse by setting aside time each day to connect.
- Be attentive: When listening, give full attention through proper posture and eye contact. And shut off distractions like the phone or television.
- Be understanding: demonstrate you understood what was said by repeating back in your own words what was communicated to you.
- Be prayerful: ask God to help you be a better listener.
