ST. MARY'S FOOD KITCHEN

St. Mary's Food Kitchen has opened back up and is serving hot meals again. A group from Holy Trinity takes bread, cakes, pies, and salads to serve at the food kitchen the first Tuesday of each month. Price Chopper typically donates the bread, cakes & pies. Prior to the first Tuesday we set out 16 containers in the back of church and ask members of the parish to fill them with either fruit, fruit salad, lettuce salad, pasta salad or something similar. Anyone is welcome to make a salad. This month the salad containers will be set out July 23rd. We ask that you return them no sooner than Sunday, August 1st but no later than Tuesday, August 3rd by 8 am. Place them in the refrigerators in the church basement. Thank you.
