The sad news of Fr. Pete's death came as a shock to many. I first met Fr. Pete when he was at Assumption Church in Topeka. John and I had only two of our children at this point, and we would sit in the front row. Every time he was the presiding priest, John and I would have a discussion after Mass about the homily and how it pertained to life. So, when Fr. Pete was assigned to Holy Trinity in 2015, I felt a strong calling to become more involved. This led to me pursuing the youth minister position when our previous youth minister left at the beginning of the year 2016. I often say that God has a sense of humor.

Let me elaborate...A typical youth minister is usually not long out of college, single or newly married, and doesn't have children yet (or they are babies). I am not the "typical" youth minister...I have been out of college and married for a long time, and my "babies" are all adults.

Since my own children were all "out of the nest" the youth of the parish kind of became my "substitute children". Fr. Pete was open to me trying new activities with the youth, and his acceptance of the youth helped when I was working to get them more involved in the Church. There were times he would bring over donuts the day after a Rake and Run as a thank you for cleaning up his lawn. A few of his suggestions with the youth group was to have some junk food available, make time to socialize, and get in some "Jesus" time. Fr. Pete was great about complimenting the youth, whether it pertained to school, sports, volunteer activity, and to anyone serving Mass. Father Pete will be missed tremendously by the youth of this parish!

**I am sharing my favorite picture of Fr. Pete. This picture was taken in 2018, at my house, while he was having a Mass at our Confirmation retreat. My dog, Buddie, just stood at the altar, and Fr. Pete turned to him and said, "Good, you can stand guard."
