



Food Pantry, The Knights collect food for the food pantry in the white barrel in back of church. This is especially important this time of the year. Please continue to fill the barrel each week.



The initials translate *Christus mansionem benedicat*, "Christ, bless this house," and is a sign that your family are disciples of the Lord.




