

May Eternal Light Shine Upon Them



God spoke to Jeremiah: "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I dedicated you, a prophet to the nations, I appointed you." But Jeremiah was afraid: "Lord God, I do not know how to speak. I am too young." God will not let him off the hook: "Do not say 'I am too young.' To whomever I send you, you shall go; whatever I command you, you shall speak." If God spoke to any of us, commanding us to be a prophet, we would respond pretty much as Jeremiah did. "I can't do that, Lord. I am too old, too shy, too inarticulate. Why on earth would you choose me?" And who would want to be a prophet anyway? Prophets "speak truth to a culture of lies," wrote Daniel Berrigan. Unpopularity is guaranteed.

In Sr. Joan Chittister's latest book, *The Time Is Now: A Call to Uncommon Courage*, she challenges all people of faith to live lives of prophetic spirituality. This means to live with hope and vision and to summon the courage to speak the truth wherever we live and work and worship. While we will not become another Jeremiah or Micah, a Martin Luther King or Dorothy Day, we are meant to overcome our reluctance to address the continuing social disintegration in our nation and in our world. Chittister's intent is to help her readers reclaim the "prophet within" and to have the courage to say "yes" to life. Chittister, who many recognize as a prophetic leader herself, believes that we have retreated from a suffering world into pious indifference. A private, individualistic spirituality is not a full and mature response to the Gospel.

If you are concerned about the state of the world and wonder how you can live in hope and grow in faith, I recommend this book. Chittister is a fine guide and the book is readable and short.




