The Solemnity Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

AUGUST 15, 2021

What is the Assumption?

The first name of this solemnity was the Feast of Mary, Mother of God. Later, its name in the East carried over, the Dormition (or Falling Asleep) of Mary. In the West, it became known as the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

This solemnity celebrates the fact that Mary's Assumption is "a pledge of the future participation of the members of the mystical Body of Christ in the paschal glory of the Risen Christ." It shows that the Lord "reserves a munificent reward for his humble Servant because of her faithful cooperation with the divine plan, which is a destiny of fullness, happiness, glorification of her immaculate soul, her virginal body, perfect configuration to her Risen Son" (Directory, no. 180). The Mass has a proper vigil, and the solemnity replaces the Mass of the day when it occurs on a Sunday in Ordinary Time.



What does this all mean?

On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII declared the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which the Church celebrates every year on August 15. Simply put, the dogma of the Assumption states that at the end of her life, the Blessed Virgin Mary was taken, body and soul, into Heaven.

While this event isn't reflected in Sacred Scripture, it is clearly part of the Church's earliest observance. In the sixth century, St. John Damascene wrote in one of his sermons, "Your sacred and happy soul, as nature will have it, was separated in death from your most blessed and immaculate body, and although the body was duly interred, it did not remain in the state of death, neither was it dissolved by decay; your most pure and sinless body was not left on earth, but you were transferred to your heavenly throne."

Theologically speaking, death is often understood to be a consequence of original sin. Since Mary was conceived without Original Sin, some theologians have wondered if Mary died or if perhaps she was taken into Heaven without experiencing death. The Catechism of the Catholic Church doesn't answer this question but simply states, "The most blessed Virgin Mary, when the course of her earthly life was completed, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven" (no. 974)

The Solemnity of the Assumption reminds us of the unique role that Mary served in the process of our salvation. Although she was without sin, we have the possibility of receiving God's forgiveness for our sins through Christ. Her entry into Heaven prefigures our own hope of experiencing the same eternal life.

Ordinarily, the celebration of the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a holy day of obligation for Catholics, but when it falls on a Saturday or a Monday, that obligation to attend Mass is lifted.



Memorial Union Parking

STA pays for **Mass overflow parking** in the Memorial Union Parking Ramp. We pay \$2.75 per vehicle for 90 minutes of parking, plus a 5% handling fee.

Please cross Lincoln Way at the Ash Ave. light and crosswalk. Do not cut across Lincoln Way and the median to take a "short cut." Everyone's safety is important. If parishioners are unable or unwilling to honor this request, STA paying for parking at the MU may be terminated.

—PROCEDURE—

- ◆ Take a parking stub as you enter the MU Ramp – **bring this stub with you to the church.**
- ◆ Fully insert your parking stub in the validation machine by the gathering space doors – you should hear a soft click — remove the stub —this pays for **90 minutes of parking** and lets ISU know to charge STA.
(your time begins when you enter the MU Ramp)
- ◆ at the MU Parking ramp exit, insert your validated stub into the reader to raise the exit gate
- ◆ **If you have been in the MU Ramp for more than 90 minutes** you will have to pay the overage with a credit card (no AMEX) at the exit gate OR cash at a pay station inside the Memorial Union in order to exit.

What is Catechesis of the Good Shepherd?

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a hands-on approach to religious education for children 3-12 years old based on the Montessori Method. Recognizing that children have a unique and beautiful relationship with God, the aim of this method is to foster this relationship while helping children grow in an understanding of scripture and liturgy, thus allowing them to participate more fully in the center of the Church's life – the Mass. SAINT THOMAS AQUINAS SOCIAL JUSTICE GRANTS

Social Justice Grants are awarded to local, national, and international agencies which promote the corporal and spiritual works of mercy, particularly by promoting peace and alleviating poverty and human suffering. The money is tithed by the parish comprising up to 2.5% of our weekly collections from envelopes, loose change, and direct deposits, as well as occasional designated donations. Award recipients are selected by the STA Social Justice Committee based on parish members' applications. These awards are granted annually. A minimum of 50% of the fund remain in Story County/Ames while up to 50% assist nationally and internationally. Application deadline is announced each spring.

Are you in a parish ministry in which minors are involved?

If you were required to complete a background check and complete Virtus training in the past (*the archdiocese is no longer using Virtus*) the archdiocese is requiring all those who have had the background check and completed Virtus to **RE-TRAIN**.

— CURRENT Volunteers —

Those volunteering for an average of 1 hour per week with contact with minors are required to be "retrained" by completing the Safe Environment online video through CMG (Catholic Mutual Group).
