Realm, our parish online ministry tool helps our parish community connect with you and you connect with each other and ministry leadership. If you consider yourself part of this parish family, Realm allows you to register in the parish, manage your personal information and who is allowed to see it, control your giving, indicate your ministry interests, and keep in touch with the groups that you are a member of.

Being church doesn't just happen at the church. Realm helps us serve you better and leads this parish well between Sundays.

### Frequently Asked Questions

**How secure is giving through Realm?** Realm's e-giving vendor, Vanco, provides a secure system to protect your identity and account information. Realm has thoroughly vetted Vanco and our parish office complies with the processes Vanco has in place.

**Who can see my information?** Realm is a closed system, so unlike social media, others on the Internet cannot see Realm information. The only people who could see your contact details and pictures are those who belong to STA and have logged in to Realm. Even then you can still limit who can see your information. We would hope that the directory in Realm can work like a printed directory, where you can go to get hold of one another. To be useful we need you to complete your profile and perhaps even add a photo! The directory is not available through the Realm smartphone app, only through the web app.

The Mustard Seed Farm can use them (& will pick them up)

Once again we plan on collecting however many of these bags you want to share with us, to store on the farm till we can mulch with them early next summer. Primarily potato mulching but we collected enough leaves last year to also mulch tomatoes and peppers which ended up being critical to their success with the dry summer. So its very helpful!

Black plastic bags or the brown compostable are preferred. Placing the bags upside down after filling would also be preferable so they stay dry inside.

Please text me at 515-231-2002 when you have leaves (anytime - Oct/Nov). Include name & address. I will confirm with you & let you know when pickup day will likely be for you. (Anyone who can bring their bagged leaves out to the farm gets special appreciation 😊)

## Memorial Union Parking

STA pays for **Mass overflow parking** in the Memorial Union Parking Ramp. We pay \$2.75 per vehicle for 90 minutes of parking, plus a 5% handling fee.

Please **cross Lincoln Way at the Ash Ave. light and crosswalk**. Do not cut across Lincoln Way and the median to take a "short cut." Everyone's safety is important. If parishioners are unable or unwilling to honor this request, STA paying for parking at the MU may be terminated.

### —PROCEDURE—

- ◆ Take a parking stub as you enter the MU Ramp – **bring this stub with you to the church.**
- ◆ Fully insert your parking stub in the validation machine by the gathering space doors – you should hear a soft click — remove the stub —this pays for **90 minutes of parking** and lets ISU know to charge STA. *(your time begins when you enter the MU Ramp)*
- ◆ at the MU Parking ramp exit, insert your validated stub into the reader to raise the exit gate
- ◆ **If you have been in the MU Ramp for more than 90 minutes** you will have to pay the overage with a credit card (no AMEX) at the exit gate OR cash at a pay station inside the Memorial Union in order to exit.
