



### Praying with our Icon



When praying with icons there are all sorts of things to pay attention to, but the first thing to remember is that an icon is not just a picture. Yes they are pictures, but they are so much more, an icon is a window connecting us with God. We don't pray TO an icon, but rather pray IN THE PRESENCE of an icon.

Icons are meant to be gazed upon as you would gaze upon one whom you love and wish to have a deep relationship.

We have two beautiful icons at STA, but for the purpose of this reflection we have before us an icon of the crucifixion.

As you sit or kneel in the pew, let your eyes roam over the whole icon. Allow your gaze to focus on Christ crucified. What do you see? What do you notice? What stands out to you? What questions arise as you gaze at this icon? Gaze at love and allow love to gaze back at you.

Then listen for a moment to Christ as he speaks from the cross. What does he say to you? Father forgive ... ? I thirst? Father, into your hands ...? Woman, behold your son ...? Today you will be with me in paradise? It is finished? Let Jesus speak to you.

What is God trying to say to you using the imagery of the icon? Ponder the insights that have come to you and give thanks. Thanks for the gift of faith. Thanks for the gift of discipleship. Thanks for the gift of love.



### **Driving as part of STA Ministry?**

The archdiocese and parish requires that anyone who drives others (non-family members) as part of a parish ministry be at least 21 years old. The purpose is to help safeguard the parish and archdiocesan liability in case of an accident.

All parishioners who drive others as part of parish ministry must also (1) complete an online video and (2) provide proof of auto insurance and a (3) provide a copy of a valid driver's license to the parish office.

Thank you for helping with this protection and safeguard—it may seem like a hassle, but it is an attempt to curb financial liability in case of an accident in which the parish is a party. We ask for everyone's cooperation with this policy.
