

You **do** have to sign up for the 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM Masses on Sunday. Go to the home page of the St. Mary's website to sign up by clicking on the bar that says SIGN UP FOR SUNDAY MASS and RECONCILIATION. The program we use is called SignUpGenius. This is the preferred method of sign-up. You may also call the parish office to sign up (9:00 AM – 3:00 PM weekdays). **Please note: Some Sunday Masses are reserved for First Eucharist families or Confirmation families.**

OUTDOOR CONFESSIONS CONTINUE


Thanks to a generous donation, outdoor drive-up confessions will continue this winter with

THE COMMON THREAD OF HOLY SATURDAY: HOW A TRAUMA LENS CAN UNITE AND STRENGTHEN OUR CATHOLIC CHURCH
