



We share many stories about our personal lives and how our faith gets us through our tribulations. Every registered parishioner should have received a letter from me that describes the parish protocols for the liturgies of Lent, Holy Week and Easter. A schedule for those liturgies was included with the letter. I want to highlight and emphasize two items from the letter.

1) Reopening of Parishes

On March 12, Governor Walz relaxed some of the coronavirus restrictions on public gatherings in the State of Minnesota, including church services. Please note that the relaxed guidelines on church services still require that people wear masks and maintain the six foot social distancing rule. The social distancing requirement and the layout of our church prevent us from greatly increasing the number of people permitted at Mass. Therefore, we will continue our current policy requiring people to register for the weekend liturgies. You are not required to sign up for weekday liturgies. Those who have been vaccinated, including those who have been discouraged from attending Mass and serving in ministry during the pandemic because of age or physical condition, are now welcome to attend Mass according to the parish policy. Those in ministry will be contacted by your ministry leader regarding your return to ministry, the timing of your return, and any additional training required based on our new protocols. I appreciate your patience as this unfolds over the next few weeks.

2) Stimulus Payments – An opportunity for extra almsgiving?

President Biden signed into law the American Rescue Plan, aimed at easing the economic impact of the virus. A portion of the legislation includes up to \$1,400-per-person stimulus payments that will be sent to about 90% of American households. Many people need these funds to pay their bills. They have lost their job or had work hours reduced. These funds will be used to make their rent or mortgage payment, buy groceries, and pay medical bills. Other people’s economic situation has not been as significantly impacted by the virus and do not need these funds. To the parishioners in this group, I invite you to prayerfully consider extra almsgiving, by donating some or all of your stimulus payment to one of the following areas:

- St. Mary of the Lake debt reduction
- St. Mary of the Lake capital repair and replacement fund
- St. Mary of the Lake Haiti fund
- Catholic Services Appeal

Please clearly indicate your gift intention on the check. Gifts to the CSA should be made payable to the Catholic Services Appeal.

Saturday Evening Mass

During this pandemic, the 5:00 PM Saturday Mass has been livestreamed with full music. With a few exceptions, attendance at the 5:00 PM Mass has been restricted to those serving at the Mass. We will be changing that policy, beginning on April 10, 2021, the Saturday after Easter. Though two upcoming Saturday evening Masses will be restricted to First Eucharist and Confirmation candidates and their families, the general rule beginning on April 10, 2021 will be the same as the current rule on Sunday Masses. Namely, those attending Saturday evening Masses must register online and follow the COVID-19 protocols. The Saturday evening Mass will continue to be livestreamed.


