



3. How can we better assist parents in forming children as disciples who know and love Jesus and his Church?


In Synod Small Groups this fall, **you help determine the response of our local Church.** In one session per week for six weeks, you will:

MASS INFORMATION

Here is a review of our Mass sign-up procedures. You do not have to sign up for our Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday Masses at 8:00 AM. **For May 22/23 only**, you do have to sign up for the 5:00 PM Mass on Saturday and the 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM Masses on Sunday. Go to the home page of the St. Mary's website to sign up by clicking on the bar that says SIGN UP FOR SUNDAY MASS. The program we use is called SignUpGenius. This is the preferred method of sign-up. You may also call the parish office to sign up (9:00 AM – 3:00 PM weekdays).


