

## First Reading

Moses and the ancient Israelites ratified the covenant God established with them at Mount Sinai with the blood of a sacrificed animal. The sacrificed animal affirmed Israel's commitment: "We will do everything the Lord had told us." Why do you think Israel tied sacrificed blood to their verbal commitment?

## Second Reading

The author of Hebrews teaches us that the sacrificed blood of Christ sanctifies us and offers us eternal redemption. How do you see this connected to ancient Israel's practice of sacrificing animals for their blood.

## Gospel Reading

Mark's account of the institution of the Eucharist is linked to the Jewish Feast of Unleavened Bread when a Passover lamb was sacrificed. What do you think Mark is teaching us in making this connection?

**Solemnity of Corpus Christi (The Body and Blood of Christ)**

The Solemnity of Corpus Christi focuses us on the greatest gift that Jesus offered to his Church: his own body and blood. At Mass, we participate in the suffering, death and resurrection of the Lord and then receive that same Lord under the appearance of bread and wine. As Catholics, we take Jesus at his word that the consecrated bread and wine have become his Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity – not just a symbol or a sign of these realities, but Jesus himself. For this reason, the Eucharist is “the source and summit” of our life as individuals and as Church. There is no more intimate or spiritually beneficial encounter with God than to participate in the Mass. Our prayer is that we would become more like him whom we receive, that we would more closely conform ourself to the Lord.




1. What can we do to make parishes more welcoming and accessible?
