Hope for the Journey Home needs you! We are resuming normal pre-Covid operations but are short of staff right now. Daily operations start mid-June. This means we will take up to 7 families (our capacity) at a time. With the possibility of additional families entering into shelter we would also like to see our volunteers return.

Volunteers are needed to assist with the evening meal preparation and serving dinner and serving as overnight hosts. We are excited to see our previous volunteers and new ones too. We will continue to seek meal donations until we replace our cook in the early fall. **All of our weeks are currently open to all volunteers. You must comply with archdiocesan Safe Environment requirements. Scribes and Facilitators are needed for the Synod sessions in the fall. These sessions will happen between September 22 and November 3, 2021 at St. Mary of the Lake. One Scribe and one Facilitator is needed for **each** small group. If you are part of an existing small group, please consider serving in the role of Scribe or Facilitator for your group. Here are the expectations

- **Attend Fall Training:** Attend 1 training. Trainings will be offered by the Archdiocese late August and early September, 2021, and will cover (i) Synod Small Group material use and reporting feedback, and (ii) facilitator and scribe training.
- **Faithful:** Faithful practicing Catholic who desires to help others grow in their faith through the Synod small group process.
- **Prepare:** Be prepared for the weekly lessons. Arrive on time and welcome members.
- **(Facilitators) Encourage:** Encourage and joyfully support the members as you guide the discussion. Let them know you care about them and value their input. Be a good listener.
- **(Scribes) Document:** Be attentive to the discussion and document the group's feedback on the focus areas, as directed by the Synod small group materials.

Maintenance Projects – Updates

The projects at the church and the Parish Life Center have begun. I write to offer you an update on some of the projects, the tentative schedule, and a financial update. Please note change of location for weekday Mass during the time of construction.

Parish Life Center

Kohler Hall – Last week, we removed the nine old lunch tables from the wall, framed the resulting openings, installed drywall, sanded and finished the area, and painted the entire Kohler Hall.

Roofs – Three weeks ago, repairs were made to certain sections of roof to extend their life. This week, roofers will begin replacing three different sections of roof rated to be in critical condition by the person advising us. Those sections of roof are more than 20 years old.

Air Conditioning Units – The company is still waiting for the air conditioning units to arrive. We hope to complete this work before school starts in September. If not, we have aside a couple of days in October for the work to get done.

Church

Blessed Sacrament Chapel – On July 6, the workers started to patch and paint the Blessed Sacrament Chapel. The chapel will be closed for private prayer until the work is completed. The Blessed Sacrament will be removed from the chapel during the work. Those bringing Eucharist to the sick or homebound may receive your hosts after one of the Masses or by coming to the Parish Life Center during normal office hours and obtaining Eucharist from the Beatitudes Chapel.

Notre Dame Chapel – On July 6, the workers started to patch and paint the Notre Dame Chapel. The Chapel will be closed until the work is completed.

Pews – We will remove all 59 pews from the church and repair, sand, and stain them. The workers will do this by sections. On July 6, the workers started this project by removing the pews from the “bleachers” section and the area behind the piano. Chairs will replace the pews while the pews are gone.

The body of the church – On July 12, workers will begin patching and painting the interior of the church. They will also begin prepping and coating the tile floor.

Gathering Space and Entryways – On July 12, workers will begin patching and painting the gathering space and both entryways.

Cement work – On July 12, workers will begin removing and replacing sections of sidewalk near the exterior door to the Blessed Sacrament Chapel (the northeast/ Bald Eagle side of the church).

Worship Location – Change of Location for Weekday Mass during Projects

During the work in the church, we will celebrate daily Mass at 8 AM on Tuesday – Friday in Kohler Hall at the Parish Life Center and not the church. This will give the workers access to the church for the entire day. The Parish Life Center is handicap accessible and air-conditioned. The plan is to celebrate Mass on Saturday evening and Sunday morning in the church. Please listen to the announcements at Mass, visit the parish website, and read the bulletin and constant contact emails for updates on the location for Mass.



Financial Update
In the one week since announcing the projects and the \$600,000 price tag, we received approximately \$150,000 from 83 families. WOW! I am grateful for the generous and rapid response. The goal is to raise enough money to pay for this summer's projects (\$600,000) and to create a reserve that will position us to meet the future maintenance needs of the parish. Each family must prayerfully discern the amount of their gift based on your situation. I thank you in advance for making a gift that matches your circumstances.
