### SYNOD 2022 Parish Consultation with Small Groups.

There are two ways to participate in the consultation process: either at in-person hosted event at St. Mary's **or** with a small group in homes or via Zoom. Both will occur during the September 22–November 3 timeframe.

#### Here's how it will work:

- In-person hosted sessions are scheduled for September 22 and 29, October 13, 20 and 27, and November 3 from 6:30-8:30 PM at St. Mary's church. These are open to everyone!
- Arrive and find a seat at a table of about 8 (for the in-person hosted event at the church).
- Existing small groups will meet during the same week at a location, time, and day chosen by the group.
- Watch a video which will lead everyone in prayer and share teaching on our beautiful Catholic faith to inform our discussion and response.
- As you are comfortable, share your experience and ideas in discussion with your tablemates.
- Respond to ideas and offer your own suggestions on a feedback form to be considered by Archbishop Hebda.

### Scribes and Facilitators Training Dates are set!

One Scribe and one Facilitator is needed for **each** table at the hosted event and for each small group hosted in homes or via Zoom. If you are part of an existing small group, or plan to participate at the hosted session, please consider serving in the role of Scribe or Facilitator. We anticipate needing 50 scribes and 50 facilitators!

#### Register to Attend a Fall Training:

- Attend 1 training between August 23 and September 20. Registration is required. Register at [www.archspm.org/ambassadors](http://www.archspm.org/ambassadors). There are in-person and Zoom options for training.

**Facilitators:** Facilitators will facilitate the table small group discussion. The training includes an overall explanation of the event, a review of materials used during the table discussion (the "Table Discussion Guidelines" and the "Discussion Questions and Feedback Form"), and instructions for facilitating a small group.

**Scribes:** The scribes will collect the individual "Discussion and Feedback Forms" from each table member at the end of the discussion, and submit the information electronically to the Archdiocese. The training includes an explanation of how to submit the information. Note: the scribe does not document or submit information on the table discussion itself; the scribe only submits the information provided on the individual Feedback Forms collected.

## ♦♦ A MESSAGE FROM FATHER TALBOT ♦♦

### U.S. Bishops' Chairmen Respond to House Vote to Force Taxpayers to Fund Abortion Overseas

On Wednesday evening (July 25, 2021), the House voted 217 to 212 in favor of H.R. 4373, the State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs (SFOPs) appropriations bill. H.R. 4373 excludes the Helms Amendment, which says that “no foreign assistance funds may be used to pay for the performance of abortion as a method of family planning or to motivate or coerce any person to practice abortions.”

Cardinal Timothy M. Dolan of New York, chairman of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops’ (USCCB) Committee for Religious Liberty, Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann of Kansas City in Kansas, chairman of the USCCB’s Committee on Pro-Life Activities, and Bishop David J. Malloy of Rockford, chairman of the USCCB’s Committee on International Justice and Peace, issued the following statement:

"By eliminating the Helms Amendment, H.R. 4373 could force recipient countries that have strong legal and cultural opposition to abortion to embrace it in order to receive desperately needed help for their people. Pope Francis has referred to this type of situation as ideological colonization. Moreover, this legislation pays for abortions and abortion advocacy with the hard-earned tax dollars of Americans—75 percent of whom say their tax dollars should not be used to pay for abortion overseas. While this legislation contains many positive provisions that provide assistance to the poor and vulnerable worldwide, including protection of refugees, increases to humanitarian assistance, and protection of the environment, nothing can justify subsidizing the taking of innocent human life. We call on the Senate to stand against the coercive pro-abortion policies of H.R.4373 and for Congress to ultimately pass appropriations bills that respect conscience and the lives of all the vulnerable, both here and abroad."

### Parish Anniversary Celebration

The parish will celebrate our 140<sup>th</sup> anniversary on August 15, 2021.

Following the 11:00 AM Mass, the celebration will continue on the grounds of the church from noon–3:00 PM. We will have a live band, food trucks, games for the children, bingo, free ice cream from Cup and Cone, and other events. At 3:00 PM, we will draw the winning raffle tickets. We have much to celebrate after 140 years and, especially, after 15 months of COVID. I encourage everyone to join in the fun, as we celebrate all that God has done in and through the people of St. Mary of the Lake over the past 140 years.

### Vaccination and Delta Variant

Nearly 70% of Minnesotans 16 years of age and older have received a COVID-19 vaccination, which has greatly reduced the spread of the virus in our state. Sadly, other states have seen a huge increase in the number of infected people, especially in those areas in which the number of vaccinated people is low. The great majority of the new cases are attributable to the more contagious Delta variant of Covid-19. The Pfizer and Moderna vaccines have proven very effective in stopping the spread of COVID-19. Health officials encourage all persons eligible for the vaccine to be vaccinated.
