SYNOD 2022 Parish Consultation with Small Groups.

There are two ways to participate in the consultation process: either at in-person hosted event at St. Mary's *or* with a small group in homes or via Zoom. Both will occur during the September 22-November 3 timeframe.

Here's how it will work:

- In-person hosted sessions are scheduled for September 22 and 29, October 13, 20 and 27, and November 3 from 6:30-8:30 PM at St. Mary's church. These are open to everyone!
- Arrive and find a seat at a table of about 8 (for the in-person hosted event at the church).
- Existing small groups will meet during the same week at a location, time, and day chosen by the group.
- Watch a video which will lead everyone in prayer and share teaching on our beautiful Catholic faith to inform our discussion and response.
- As you are comfortable, share your experience and ideas in discussion with your tablemates.
- Respond to ideas and offer your own suggestions on a feedback form to be considered by Archbishop Hebda.

Scribes and Facilitators Training Dates are set!

One Scribe and one Facilitator is needed for *each* table at the hosted event and for each small group hosted in homes or via Zoom. If you are part of an existing small group, or plan to participate at the hosted session, please consider serving in the role of Scribe or Facilitator. We anticipate needing 50 scribes and 50 facilitators!


Register to Attend a Fall Training:

- Attend 1 training between August 23 and September 20. Registration is required. Register at www.archspm.org/ambassadors. There are in-person and Zoom options for training.

Facilitators: Facilitators will facilitate the table small group discussion. The training includes an overall explanation of the event, a review of materials used during the table discussion (the "Table Discussion Guidelines" and the "Discussion Questions and Feedback Form"), and instructions for facilitating a small group.

Scribes: The scribes will collect the individual "Discussion and Feedback Forms" from each table member at the end of the discussion, and submit the information electronically to the Archdiocese. The training includes an explanation of how to submit the information. Note: the scribe does not document or submit information on the table discussion itself; the scribe only submits the information provided on the individual Feedback Forms collected.

The Assumption of Mary into Heaven

Today, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary body and soul into heaven. The background for this great feast of the Church formally began in 1946, when Pope Pius wrote to every bishop in the world, and through the bishops to the clergy and the faithful, and asked the question of whether the bodily Assumption of Mary into heaven was to be raised to a dogma of the Catholic Faith. The Church had always recognized that the soul of Mary was in heaven. However, the question of whether her body was also in heaven was an unresolved question of faith, although many churches, prayers and sermons celebrated that belief from early in the church’s history. In response to the question of Pope Pius, the bishops, almost unanimously, replied that the faithful agreed and believed that Mary was assumed into heaven body and soul. In 1950, Pius XII declared this to be the infallible teaching of the Church. The Holy Father, the bishops and the Catholic faithful believed this to be the case because:

- Mary was conceived without sin and bore the Son of God.
- She lived her life in perfect accordance with God’s plan for her.
- She remained faithful to her Son.

We celebrate this Solemnity with great hope and joy because Mary, human like us, lives in heaven the way we long to exist. Mary’s eternal life with God, both body and soul, is the promised life for each one of us who is faithful to Christ. We pray that through Mary’s intercession and the grace of God, we will reign in glory with Christ, body and soul.

Happy 140th Anniversary St. Mary of the Lake

The Solemnity of the Assumption marks the anniversary of our parish. In 1877, Bishop Grace assigned Fr. Joseph Goiffon to minister to the Catholics of White Bear Lake and for four years Father Goiffon celebrated Mass most Sundays at the Markoe cottage. As the community grew, Bishop Grace instructed Fr. Goiffon to build a church in White Bear Lake. Father Goiffon and the parishioners built a 30' x 60' church on Bald Eagle Avenue between 1st and 2nd Street. Bishop Grace dedicated the church on the 15th of August 1881. This weekend we celebrate the 140th anniversary of the dedication of that first church at St. Mary of the Lake. We give thanks to God for those who have come before us and shared their time, talent and treasure in building this wonderful community and for making us the stewards of this legacy. Through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our patroness, may we be the disciples Jesus is calling us to be and generously share our time, talent and treasure in building the kingdom of God in and through our parish.

Following today’s 11:00 AM Mass, our anniversary celebration will continue on the grounds of the church from noon – 3:00 PM. We will have a live band, food trucks, games for the children, bingo, free ice cream from Cup and Cone, and other events. At 3:00 PM, we will draw the winning raffle tickets. I encourage everyone to join in the fun as we celebrate all that God has done in and through the people of St. Mary of the Lake for 140 years.

Our outdoor celebration that day will take place from 12:00 until 3:00 PM on the church grounds. **Don't forget your lawn chair! WEEKEND MASSES

We will notify you by September 1 if your first or second choice was assigned to you.








