Thanks to everyone who attended and supported the 140th anniversary celebration last Sunday. We were blessed with perfect weather, a great band, delicious food, free ice cream and cupcakes, sparkling jewelry, and many busy volunteers. I am grateful to Lynn Arcand, the chair of the anniversary committee, and all the members of the committee, the parish staff, and all the volunteers who made the anniversary such a great event. I offer thanks to our parishioner, Steve Chirhart, and his band Emerson Avenue, to our sponsors, Mueller Memorial and Premier Banks, to Cup n Cone for providing 370 free ice cream treats, to the Knights of Columbus for managing the bingo, and to the owners of our food trucks for delicious food and for donating a share of their sales to the parish. Everyone enjoyed being together and having fun, which were the two goals of the event.

Funeral Ministry – Thanks

We celebrated five funerals at the parish this week, two of them with luncheons. I am grateful to those involved in assisting at the funeral Mass and the funeral luncheons, which offer great peace and comfort to the families. Repairs Update

Because of the funeral schedule, the work inside the church was delayed. The workers still need to finish the floor and touch up the painting. We are waiting for the arrival of the kneelers and the acoustical panels. I am working on a design for the tabernacle stand, which will need to be built. Great progress was made in the past six weeks, thanks to the dedication and professionalism of our workers. Thanks to the 383 families for making gifts totaling \$426,000 for the repairs. I encourage all families to share in covering the cost of the repairs to the church and the Parish Life Center.

Vacation Bible School

Thanks to the volunteers and staff who planned and served at Vacation Bible School. The young people had a marvelous time learning about God's love for them. This weeklong event is an important part of the teaching ministry of the parish.

Haiti Update

On August 14, 2021, a 7.2 magnitude earthquake hit SW Haiti, causing more than 1400 deaths, thousands of injuries, and destruction of homes, businesses and churches. Just a few days later, a tropical storm traveled over Haiti, bringing high winds and torrential rain. I have heard from Sr. Evelynne, who reported that the school buildings, the convent and the home for the elderly withstood the earthquake, because they had been built according to industry standards. The buildings were built that way, thanks to your generosity. I will keep you updated on the events in Haiti and the ways that we can help. In the meantime, please pray for the Haitian people and for those coming to their assistance.



WEEKEND MASSES

New data suggests that an emerging variant, the Delta variant, is different than past versions of the virus and spreads about twice as easily from one person to another. With the Delta variant, fully vaccinated people may be able to pass the disease to others. However, the vaccines still work. Fully vaccinated people are less likely to get infected, and if a vaccinated person gets infected, the illness will likely be mild. The vaccine also greatly reduces the chance of hospitalization and death.



Because the Delta variant of COVID 19 is shown to spread more easily, the MDH and CDC recommend everyone, both fully vaccinated and unvaccinated, wear a mask in public, indoor settings in areas with substantial or high transmission. Since Ramsey county is an area of substantial and increasing transmission, wearing a mask at Mass is recommended. If you want to attend Mass and you are not ready to be in a crowd, please see an usher and we will find a place for you to sit.

2021-2022 SACRAMENT PREPARATION

We are now taking registrations for Confirmation and First Reconciliation/First Eucharist. The **registration deadline** for Confirmation is Wednesday, September 15. Registration forms and schedules are available on the parish website. Proof of baptism is required for registration. According to diocesan policy, proof of baptism must be a newly issued baptism certificate. Contact the parish where your child was baptized.

One Scribe and one Facilitator is needed for **each** table at the hosted event. - **Faithful:** Faithful practicing Catholic who desires to help others grow in their faith through the Synod small group process.
- **Prepare:** Be prepared for the weekly lessons. Arrive on time and welcome members.
- **(Facilitators) Encourage:** Encourage and joyfully support the members as you guide the discussion. Let them know you care about them and value their input. Be a good listener.
- **(Scribes) Document:** Be attentive to the discussion and document the group's feedback on the focus areas, as directed by the Synod small group materials.


