

Back to School at Frassati Catholic Academy

Tuesday, September 7, marked the opening of the new school year at Frassati Catholic Academy. Frassati will be following guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the MN Departments of Public Health and Education, and the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis. We have 268 K-8 students enrolled, an increase from last year’s enrollment. We are blessed to be adding a third section of kindergarten to accommodate our growth. Grades 1-5 have two sections each and grades 6-8 have one section each. We have 54 preschool students, an increase of 15 from last year. Please keep our students and staff in your prayers. The students and staff will be wearing masks to begin the year, as strongly recommended by the MN Department of Education. If you visit the Parish Life Center when school children are present (which is basically the entire work day), you will be required to wear a mask.

Church Repairs

The cement work around the outside of the church is 90% complete. The work on the church sanctuary is 90% complete. We are still waiting on the kneelers, the acoustical panels and the tabernacle at the church. I am grateful to the 451 families who have donated \$515,000 toward these projects. I encourage every family to make a gift, so that we can reach (and surpass) our goal of \$600,000. Every gift is appreciated.

Haiti – Special Collection – September 11-12, 2021 (This weekend)

Archbishop Hebda invites all Catholics in the archdiocese to join Catholics throughout the United States in an emergency collection for those suffering from the devastating earthquake in Haiti. On August 14, a massive 7.2 magnitude quake hit Haiti, leveling homes and businesses, leaving many people without shelter or food. A few days later, Tropical Storm Grace brought high winds and torrential rain to Haiti, complicating the rescue efforts. Sister Evelynne and her community are fine; the school, the care center and the convent suffered only minor damage, because they were constructed to hurricane strength. Sadly, very few people have the resources to build their homes, businesses and churches to hurricane strength, meaning that many in the Marfranc area have suffered greatly. We will give our money directly to Sister, so that she can distribute the funds to those most in need. I ask you to be generous in your giving and in your prayers. Please note “Haiti” in the memo line of your check so that your gift is recorded accurately.

Labor Day

Last Monday, the country celebrated Labor Day. The proper understanding of work, property and the human person has long been a concern of the Church. A most basic understanding is that the worker must always be respected and treated as a human person made in the image and likeness of God and never be used as a piece of property solely for economic gain. Work must be seen in the light of our dignity as human persons and God’s desire for us to advance the common good and bring about God’s kingdom on earth. A good piece of reading on Labor Day is *Laborem Exercens (Through Work)*, written by Pope Saint John Paul II in 1981.

WEEKEND MASSES

New data suggests that an emerging variant, the Delta variant, is different than past versions of the virus and spreads about twice as easily from one person to another. With the Delta variant, fully vaccinated people may be able to pass the disease to others. However, the vaccines still work. Fully vaccinated people are less likely to get infected, and if a vaccinated person gets infected, the illness will likely be mild. The vaccine also greatly reduces the chance of hospitalization and death.



Because the Delta variant of COVID-19 is shown to spread more easily, **the MDH and CDC recommend everyone, both fully vaccinated and unvaccinated, wear a mask in public, indoor settings in areas with substantial or high transmission.** Since Ramsey County is an area of substantial and increasing transmission, wearing a mask at Mass is recommended. If you want to attend Mass and you are not ready to be in a crowd, please see an usher and we will find a place for you to sit.

WHY ARE THEY COUNTING?

You may notice that we are counting the number of people at all the weekend Masses. The information is used to help us make decisions.

- **(Scribes) Document:** Be attentive to the discussion and document the group's feedback on the focus areas, as directed by the Synod small group materials.
