

World Day of Migrants and Refugees

“For nearly a half century, the Catholic Church in the United States has celebrated National Migration Week, which is an opportunity for the Church to reflect on the circumstances confronting migrants, including immigrants, refugees, children, and victims and survivors of human trafficking. National Migration Week for 2021 takes place September 20-26, and will climax with the Vatican’s celebration of the World Day of Migrants and Refugees (WDMR), which always falls on the last Sunday of September. The primary theme for this year’s WDMR is “Towards an ever wider ‘WE’”. In his letter announcing this year’s theme (https://www.vatican.va/content/francesco/en/messages/migration/documents/papa-francesco_20210503_world-migrants-day-2021.html), Pope Francis emphasizes that “this focus calls on us to ensure that ‘after all this, we will think no longer in terms of ‘them’ and ‘those,’ but only ‘us’ (Fratelli tutti, no. 35). And this universal us must become a reality first of all within the Church which is called to cultivate communion in diversity.” In solidarity with the Vatican, National Migration Week will use the same theme as WDMR – “Towards an ever wider WE’ – but will emphasize the particular ways in which this theme and its application to the migration question is important for the Catholic Church in the United States.” (USCCB, Justice for Immigrants, <https://justiceforimmigrants.org/take-action/national-migration-week>).

Refugees are individuals who have fled their countries of origin, having well-founded fear of persecution for reasons of race, religion, nationality, membership in particular social group, or political opinion.

Migrant is a broad term that applies to an individual who willingly leaves home and moves from one place to another, most often in search of employment. This includes people who move from one region to another within the borders of their own country (internal migration); or move from their country of birth to another country or countries.

Sometimes, the term migrant can also include refugees, but the term refugee does not always include migrants.

As we witness the humanitarian crisis at our southern border, let us pray that all people will be honored and respected as beloved sons and daughters of God.

WEEKEND MASSES

New data suggests that an emerging variant, the Delta variant, is different than past versions of the virus and spreads about twice as easily from one person to another. With the Delta variant, fully vaccinated people may be able to pass the disease to others. However, the vaccines still work. Fully vaccinated people are less likely to get infected, and if a vaccinated person gets infected, the illness will likely be mild. The vaccine also greatly reduces the chance of hospitalization and death.



Because the Delta variant of COVID-19 is shown to spread more easily, **the MDH and CDC recommend everyone, both fully vaccinated and unvaccinated, wear a mask in public, indoor settings in areas with substantial or high transmission.** Since Ramsey County is an area of substantial and increasing transmission, wearing a mask at Mass is recommended. If you want to attend Mass and you are not ready to be in a crowd, please see an usher and we will find a place for you to sit.

WHY ARE THEY COUNTING?

You may notice that we are counting the number of people at all the weekend Masses. The information is used to help us make decisions.


This week, students were introduced to the generosity of this year-long project and got to collect their September book, *The Cool Bean*.

- **Prepare:** Be prepared for the weekly lessons. Arrive on time and welcome members.
- **(Facilitators) Encourage:** Encourage and joyfully support the members as you guide the discussion. Let them know you care about them and value their input. Be a good listener.
- **(Scribes) Document:** Be attentive to the discussion and document the group's feedback on the focus areas, as directed by the Synod small group materials.
