

The final 2 Synod sessions at St. Mary's are on Wednesday October 27 and Wednesday November 3.

WEEKEND MASSES

New data suggests that an emerging variant, the Delta variant, is different than past versions of the virus and spreads about twice as easily from one person to another. With the Delta variant, fully vaccinated people may be able to pass the disease to others. However, the vaccines still work. Fully vaccinated people are less likely to get infected, and if a vaccinated person gets infected, the illness will likely be mild. The vaccine also greatly reduces the chance of hospitalization and death.

Because the Delta variant of COVID-19 is shown to spread more easily, **the MDH and CDC recommend everyone, both fully vaccinated and unvaccinated, wear a mask in public, indoor settings in areas with substantial or high transmission.** Since Ramsey County is an area of substantial and increasing transmission, wearing a mask at Mass is recommended. If you want to attend Mass and you are not ready to be in a crowd, please see an usher and we will find a place for you to sit.

APPALACHIA CHRISTMAS

St. Mary's will be sending a monetary donation to the four parishes in Kentucky. We will **NOT** be collecting items here at the church. However, if you would like to donate a Christmas item you can drop it off at St. Pius at door A. The semi truck leaves Minnesota mid-November to bring these gifts to Kentucky. We received this from Father Adams, pastor at St. Francis of Assisi Church in Pikeville:

"The COVID-19 pandemic has been difficult for the whole world, but it has harmed the people of Appalachia in a particular way. And yet, as we look back at this past Christmas Season, we realize how truly blessed we are. With your help again this year, in spite of the pandemic, we were able to minister to many families in need in the heart of Appalachia in eastern Kentucky. Even though the economy remains depressed and the needs are great, the people are grateful for all of God's blessings and especially for the generosity of our benefactors."
