

What happens after the Synod?


The Synod Parish Consultation with Small Groups was the next step in a Synod process that culminates with a Synod Assembly at Pentecost 2022. After considering the Synod recommendations, Archbishop Hebda will write a Pastoral Letter in November 2022 on the Feast of Christ the King, leading to a Pastoral Plan to move our Archdiocese into the future.



What will be in that plan, and how will it affect our parish?

Saint of the Week

You may recognize the name St. Frances Xavier Cabrini (1850-1917) as the first United States citizen to become a saint. Known for her deep trust in God, she was a courageous woman doing the work of Christ.

Her life service began when she was first refused admission to the religious order which had educated her to be a teacher. Not one to take things at face value, she instead focused her charitable work at the House of

Providence Orphanage in Cadogno, Italy, and in 1877 professed vows there and took the religious habit.

When the bishop closed the orphanage in 1880, he named St. Frances Xavier Cabrini prioress of the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart. However, she had a dream she was determined to fulfill. Since her early childhood, she had dreamed of being a missionary in China. Pope Leo XIII, however, urged her to see the need in the west. She traveled with six of her fellow religious sisters to New York City, where they worked with the thousands of Italian immigrants residing there.

Although she experienced many disappointments during this time, she persevered. When she arrived in New York, the house intended to be her first orphanage in the United States was not available. Rather than come back to Italy and the order she oversaw, she instead found a way to establish that orphanage elsewhere—plus a few more. Throughout her life, she is known for founding 67 institutions dedicated to caring for the poor, the abandoned, the uneducated, and the sick. She died of malaria in her own Columbus Hospital in Chicago in 1917.

Opening Our Hearts to Families in Transition

Did you know that nearby (on the campus of Guardian Angels Catholic Community in



Oakdale) is one of the very few family shelters in our area, Hope for the Journey Home? Up to seven families at a time can stay in the former rectory of the parish as they search for permanent housing. Volunteers can cook or serve an evening meal or stay overnight in a private room.

St. Mary of the Lake has committed to one week each quarter and our week for volunteering at HJH is December 5-11.

Synod Small Groups – Thanks

On behalf of Archbishop Hebda, I offer thanks to those who participated in the Synod small groups. We offered two options for each of the six weeks and approximately 100 people participated each week, in addition to those who met in their regular small groups. The comments of the participants, along with comments from participants throughout the archdiocese, have been sent to Archbishop Hebda. That data will inform the next level of consultation, which will take place at the deanery level during January and February (a deanery is a group of parishes within a defined geographical area of the diocese). The actual Synod will take place on Pentecost, June 2022.

November – A Month to Remember Our Beloved Dead

The Church dedicates November to praying for the Holy Souls in Purgatory—those who have died in God’s grace, but with some attachment or effect of sin. They are guaranteed heaven, but they are not yet ready for perfect communion with God. As I noted in my All Souls Day homily, they can no longer help themselves; they rely on us, the living members of the Body of Christ. We help in their purification by praying for them, celebrating Mass for their intention, and completing works of penance or acts of mercy and justice in their name. If our loved ones are already in communion with God, our prayers are not in vain. They redound to our benefit or to another soul in need of purification.

Funeral Planning

Everyone is going to have a funeral. Therefore, the Church encourages everyone to pre-plan their funeral. Pre-planning your funeral allows you to memorialize your intentions about the visitation, the Mass, the burial and a luncheon or other post-Mass celebration. Pre-planning your funeral is a wonderful gift to yourself and to your family. Many people (including myself) talk about the need for planning our funeral, but few of us actually follow through with the plans. I encourage everyone to let your loved ones know your desires regarding your funeral. Resources for planning a funeral are available on the parish website. WEEKEND MASSES

New data suggests that an emerging variant, the Delta variant, is different than past versions of the virus and spreads about twice as easily from one person to another. With the Delta variant, fully vaccinated people may be able to pass the disease to others. However, the vaccines still work. Fully vaccinated people are less likely to get infected, and if a vaccinated person gets infected, the illness will likely be mild. The vaccine also greatly reduces the chance of hospitalization and death.

Because the Delta variant of COVID-19 is shown to spread more easily, **the MDH and CDC recommend everyone, both fully vaccinated and unvaccinated, wear a mask in public, indoor settings in areas with substantial or high transmission.** Since Ramsey County is an area of substantial and increasing transmission, wearing a mask at Mass is recommended. If you want to attend Mass and you are not ready to be in a crowd, please see an usher and we will find a place for you to sit.
