

Did you know? There are wonderful facilities and resources available to mothers, couples and families facing an unexpected pregnancy. Three local centers we would like to highlight are: Women's Life Care Center, Abria Pregnancy Resources and Guiding Star Wakota.

These remarkable life centers support the mothers and families through the pregnancy and beyond. The staff and volunteers at these centers are more than willing to help any mother and family in need that chooses life for their baby. Each center provides multiple services along with a 3D Ultrasound of their precious child.

Listed below are some of the services provided:

- Free pregnancy testing
- Pregnancy verification
- 3D Ultrasound of their child
- Pre-natal care referrals
- Life Coaching available
- Many offer classes related to pregnancy, childbirth, childcare, etc.
- May provide resources for housing, legal help, food resources, etc.
- Layette, diapers, clothing, and some equipment
- May help with employment skills or education
- Budgeting and finance
- Much more

Facts: In 2019 alone, there were more than 9900 abortions performed in Minnesota with Planned Parenthood accounting for 65% of the abortions in the state. However, about 3000 mothers chose life because of the Women's Right to Know Law in our state. (MCCL July 1, 2020)

What can we do? It is important that as Catholics we know what is available to help women, couples and families facing an unexpected pregnancy and do not know where to turn. We can investigate volunteer opportunities, financially support them, refer those needing help to them, fight for legislation that protects the unborn, and pray for those doing this much needed work.



CAMPAIGN UPDATE



As of the end of December 2020, of the **\$1,394,097** pledged, we have collected **\$968,049**.

So far we have contributed \$300,000 to our endowments, allocated \$117,025 toward capital campaign expenses, with an additional \$2,610 in postage for a total of **\$699,937**. This total includes \$224,333 spent so far on the school preschool initiative, and \$15,868 on improvements to the Adoration Chapel, and \$42,711 on the parking lot.

OUR PEOPLE



The 75th anniversary of Saint Rose of Lima Catholic School in 2015 brought increased support and excitement for the school. At that time there was no annual fund or focus on donor stewardship. That's when parent Liz Halberg, who has worked in fund-raising and development for 23 years, saw an opportunity to use her experience to help generate increased support for the school.

"I did not want to see the energy and excitement that was built up around the anniversary go away," she says. "I wanted to use what I do for a living to make an impact."

With encouragement from principal Sean Slaikeu (a tireless fund-raiser as well), and volunteer help from Amy Lamb, a former Saint Rose parent, Liz put together a targeted annual campaign to diversify the funding of the school. "Our focus was on individual donors—parishioners, alumni, parents and family members of students," she says. "My belief is we just don't want a donor, we want a partner, someone who is informed and invested, and feels a part of what we are doing."

While the needs of the school vary from year to year, development efforts are a combination of grants, individuals and events such as the marathon and raffle.

Although the Halbergs are not Catholic, the school is very much a part of their family. "It's not just the exceptional education our children receive," says Liz. "It's the faith formation we see in them—how they act in the community, how they act at home, how they treat other people. Saint Rose School impacts so much of our lives right now."

Other things to know about the Halberg family:

- Liz is a native of Virginia, MN. She graduated from the University of Minnesota with a B.A. in journalism and marketing. She is director of development and communication for Project Success, a non-profit program designed to help 16,000 Minneapolis Public School students in grades 6 through 12 connect to their purpose.
- Matt, her husband of almost 16 years, grew up in Burnsville and graduated from the University of Wisconsin with a B.S. degree in political science and a J.D. from Hamline Law. He works in commercial real estate. Matt has been active in the Saint Rose Boy Scouts program.
- Michael is in grade 6 and Emma in grade 3. Both have been at Saint Rose School since they started in pre-K at age 3. "They love the school," says their mother. "They do not want to be anywhere else."
