

FROM OUR PASTOR



Brothers and sisters,

In the last month I've celebrated two weddings – the first I've done in a long time. I also went to the receptions, something I can't always do. (One of the best opening lines I've heard in a long time was one best man's speech, "I'm going to offer a few words for the bride and groom, but first, I'd like everyone to know that Governor Walz of the state of Minnesota has lifted the ban on standing ovations").

For both these brides and grooms, they were the first of their siblings to marry. That means that there is an extra level of nervousness because it's the "first time" for everyone – not just the couple, but the parents and family of the bride and groom too. You may have gone to plenty of weddings, but this is your wedding.

I have done enough weddings at this point that my own "ceremonial game face" is pretty calm. I enjoy it all – whatever happens perfectly and whatever does not go exactly to plan. A wedding is glorious, not because it goes perfectly according to plan, but because everyone is going through it together, with all the accompanying majesty, love, joy, beauty, tears, awkwardness, delays of schedule, make-up emergencies, and wait-what-happens-next blank stares.

This is an icon of the Christian life too. So often we can get angry at ourselves or others because our following of Jesus isn't picture perfect. It's not going according to plan – meaning my plan. Our discipleship contains a lot of "first times," and for some reason we're surprised when we don't get them right. That's not necessarily sinful; it could mean that we're simply learning for the "first time." Would we get mad when someone picks up a violin for the first time and isn't able to execute a Mozart concerto? But that's often exactly how we feel at ourselves in our faith life.

A marriage is about more than just the wedding day, and a friendship with Jesus is about more than what happened just yesterday. So, let's embrace the awkwardness, savor the beauty, and have cheerful hearts. Jesus has many more "first times" for us



CAMPAIGN UPDATE & STEWARDSHIP

As of the end of May 2021, of the **\$1,394,097** pledged, we have collected **\$1,062,092**.

Thank you for your contributions. Please remember checks for the campaign should be made out to Saint Rose of Lima.

So far we have contributed \$300,000 to our endowments, and allocated \$117,025 toward capital campaign expenses. We have spent \$224,474 on the preschool initiative (landscaping, playground and security system), \$34,312 on new ministries (Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and livestreaming technology), \$35,997 in capital improvements, primarily related to parking lot improvements, and \$31,283 on the Chapel renovation. The total spent thus far is **\$743,090**.

OUR PEOPLE



The fortuitous discovery of Saint Rose parish and school about four years ago has had an impact on the spiritual life of David Toews, his wife Sarah Green and their family. "We were looking for school options for our two youngest children, and even though we belonged to Corpus Christi, Saint Rose School was never on our radar," says David. Until it was.

The couple lived in Northeast Minneapolis after they married in 2008. "As our children hit school age we realized we were looking for a deeper faith-based education and a strong faith community in which they could grow and flourish," says Sarah.

At first the couple thought Saint Rose School looked quiet and unassuming from the outside. "However, the inside told a different story," says Sarah. "The faculty and staff radiated true care for the students and they were fundamentally engaged to help them become faithful, caring members of the community."

The school worked out better than the family could have hoped for. They enrolled Gus in Kindergarten (he is now in grade 3), transferred Alice the next year (she is now in grade 7). They also moved to Roseville and increased their level of participation in the parish community.

David is on the Parish Council, lectors and recently joined the Men's Bible Study group. Sarah is a member of the school grants board and is looking forward to joining the choir when it resumes. Alice is an altar server.

Other things to know about David and Sarah:

- David was raised in St. Ignatius parish in Spring Valley, MN, went to college in St. Cloud and joined Corpus Christi after he and Sarah were married. He works as a database administrator for McKesson, a pharmaceutical company.
- Sarah grew up in the Twin Cities and moved to rural Minnesota in high school. Her faith has always been a central part of her life; she gives credit to the hybrid family model she was raised in (her parents divorced; she was baptized Lutheran, her father remarried in the Catholic church, she was confirmed Catholic). Sarah works for a subsidiary of SAS Institute, an analytics software firm, where she leads the training team.
- David's passion is biking; Sarah's is kayaking and canoeing. She is also a Master Gardener. Everyone in the family is a voracious reader. They all enjoy outdoor activities. Oldest daughter Paige is a high school senior headed for the University of Minnesota-Duluth this fall.


